PURPOSE OF NOTICE

OVERVIEW

Basic Purpose and Background

Temporarily adds a rule and temporarily suspends <u>140 IAC 7-5-1</u> through <u>140 IAC 7-5-11</u> concerning the approval of truck driver training schools. The proposed rules bring <u>140 IAC</u> into conformity with the implementation of the Entry-Level Driver Training under 49 CFR § 380, Subparts F and G, which went into effect on February 7, 2022.

PROPOSED INTERIM RULE

SECTION 1. A business enterprise that educates, trains, or otherwise prepares a person to operate a commercial motor vehicle is approved by the bureau to operate in the state if the business enterprise is listed on the Training Provider Registry as described in 49 CFR Part 380.
