# High School Pipeline and College Preparation


- 10% of high school graduates are Scholars
- The percentage of high school graduates who are Scholars peaked in 2014, with 16% of high school graduates as Scholars (due to the financial impacts of the Great Recession).
- 77% of high schoolers in the Scholars program earn AP or dual credit
- 47% of Scholars earned an Academic Honors diploma

### **College Access**

 86% of Scholars go straight to college after high school, more than double the rate of their non-Scholar, low-income peers. The statewide average is 61%


#### Early Success in College

 43% of Scholars students meet all three early college success metrics (no remediation; complete all attempted credits; persist to second year)




# College-Going Rates by Socioeconomic Status

### 21st Century Scholars' Early Success In College




% Early College Success (No Remediation, Earn All Credits Attempted, & Persist to Second Year)

Statewide Average: 15.7%




### **On-Time Completion**

Statewide Average: 48.4%




### **Extended-Time Completion**


 51% of Scholars graduate from college within 6 years
