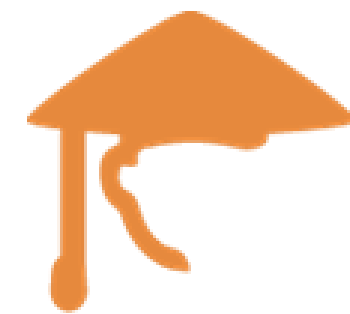

Measurable distinction of **social and economic mobility and prosperity.**



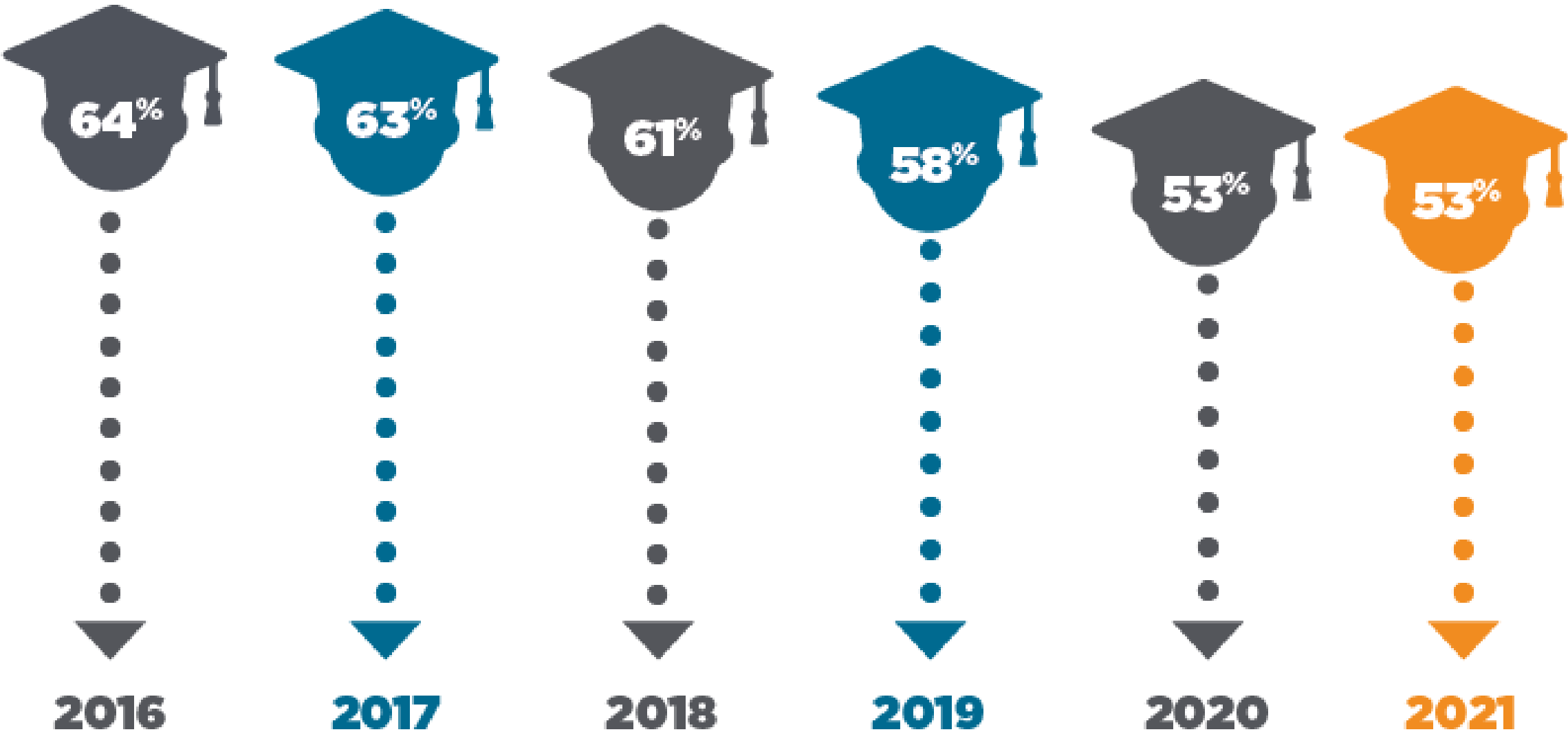
As a **recognized state for growing or starting a business** based upon the strength of **human capital.**

INDIANA'S COLLEGE-GOING RATE



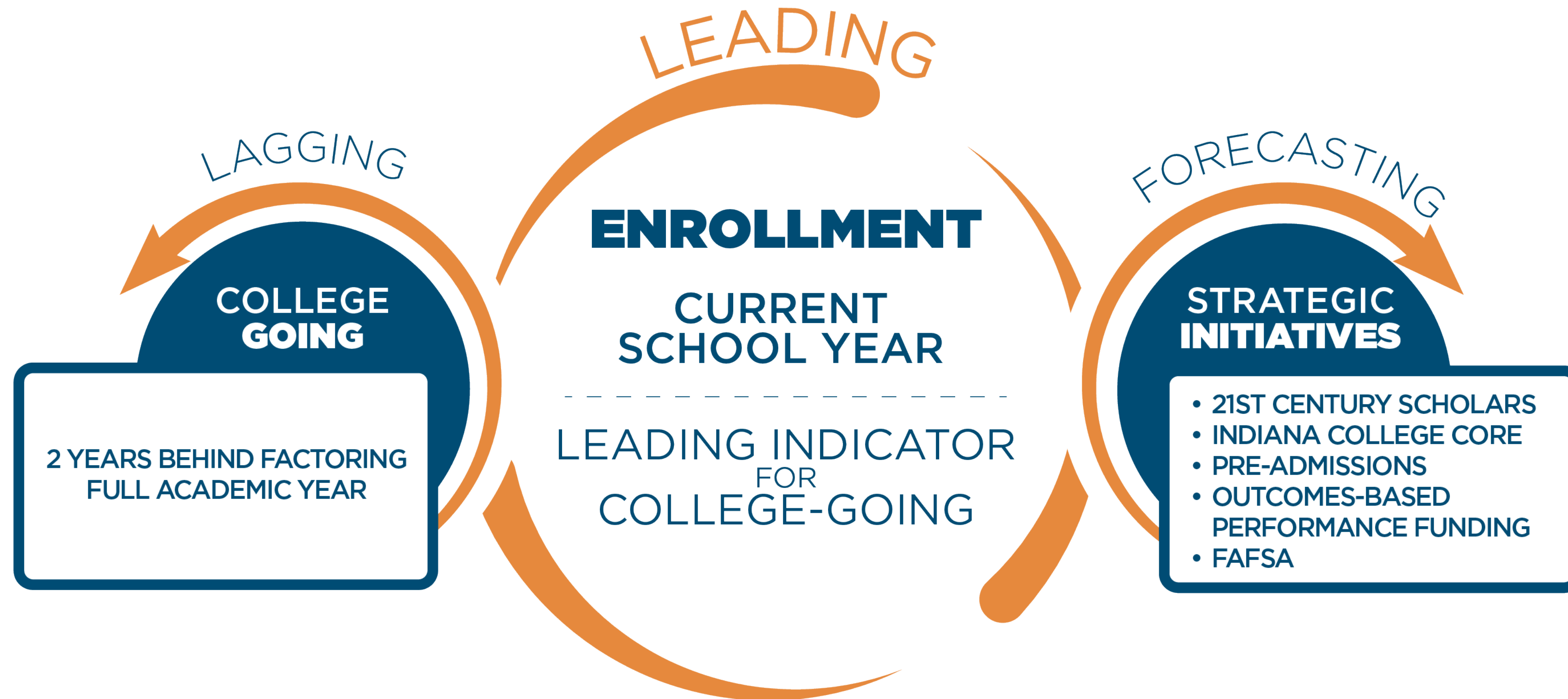
HIGH SCHOOLERS GOING STRAIGHT TO COLLEGE

Indiana's college-going rate has declined yearly since 2015, but 2021 was the first year the rate held steady at 53 percent.



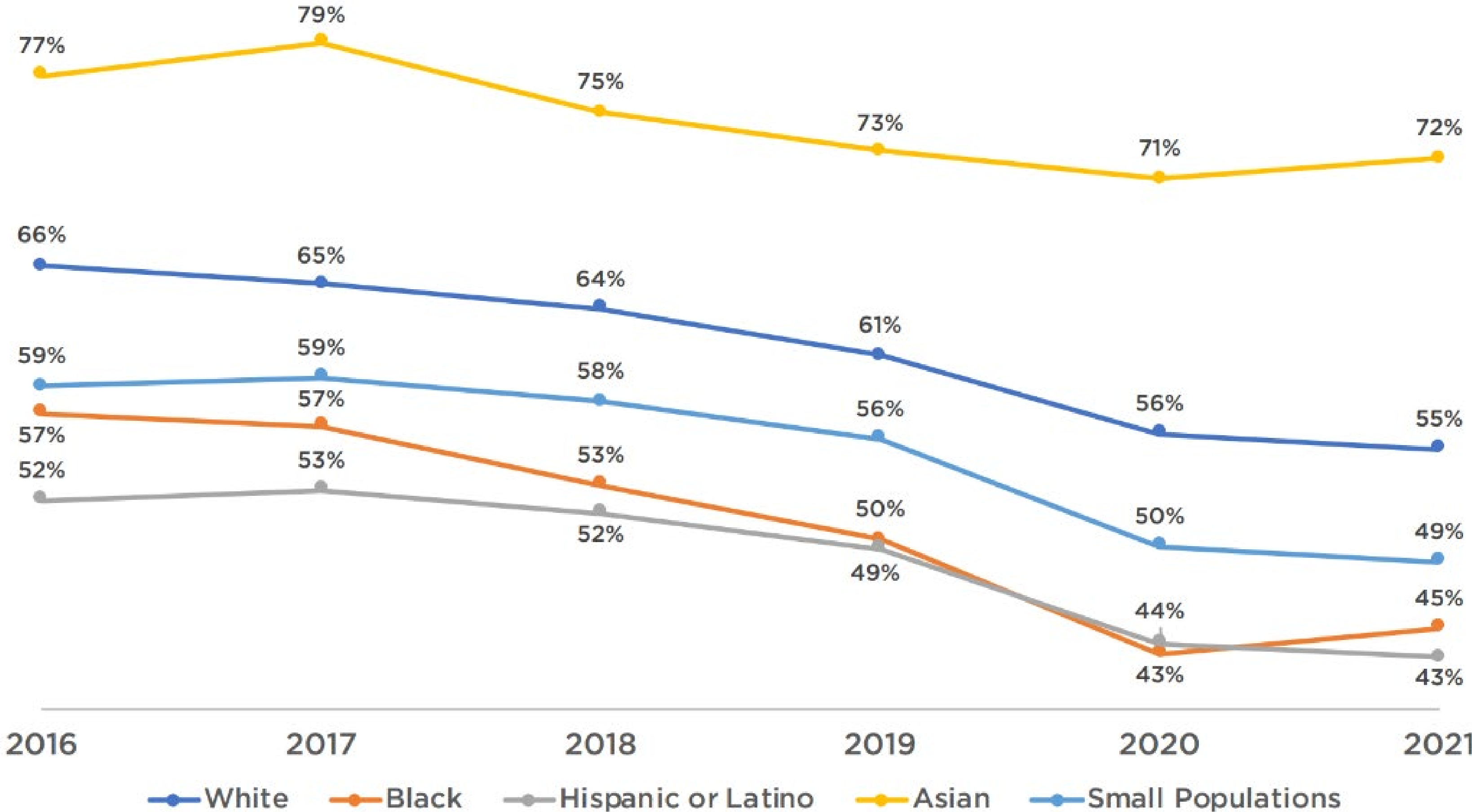

INDIANA'S COLLEGE-GOING RATE

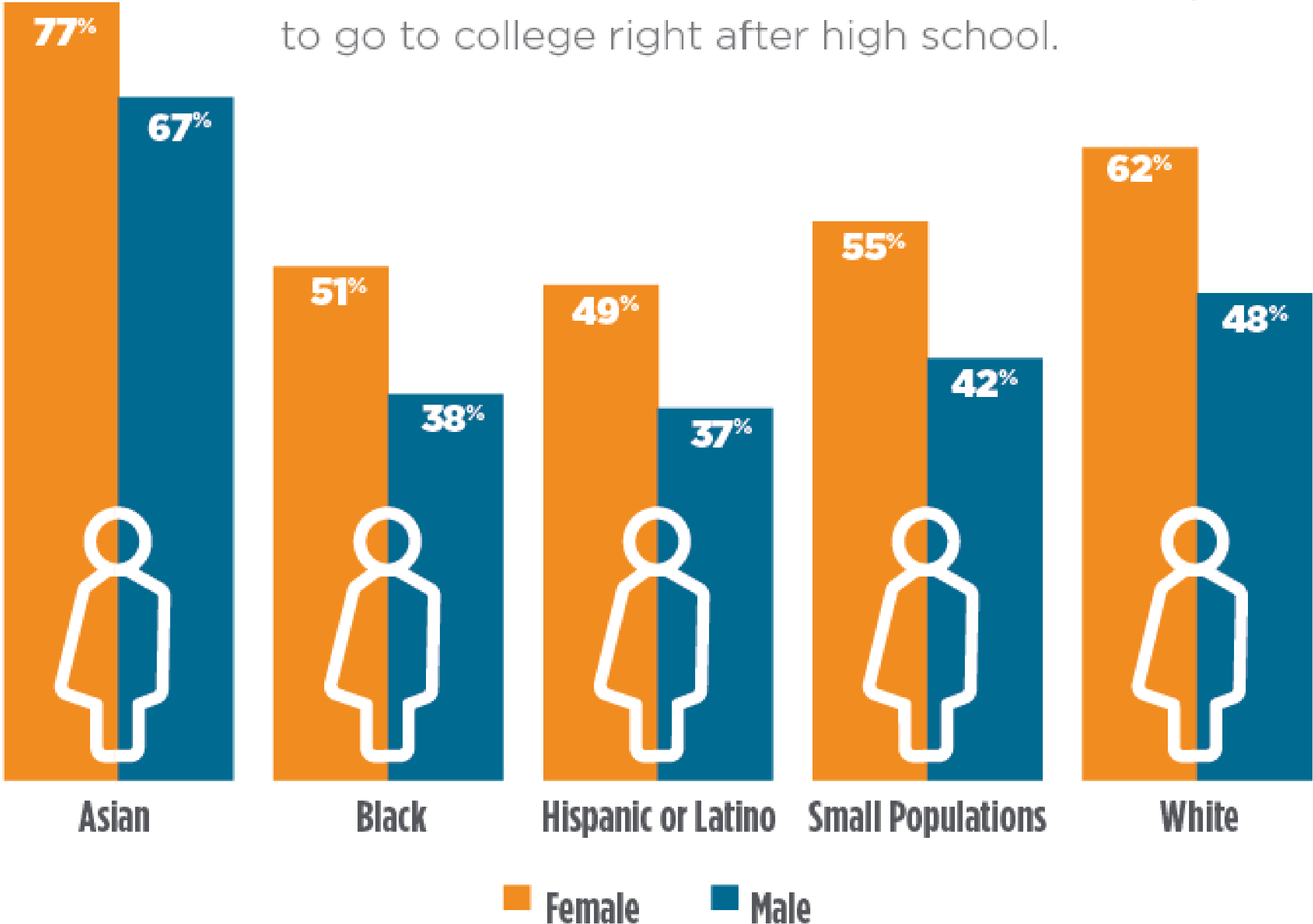
INDIANA'S EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM HAS GROWING GAPS:

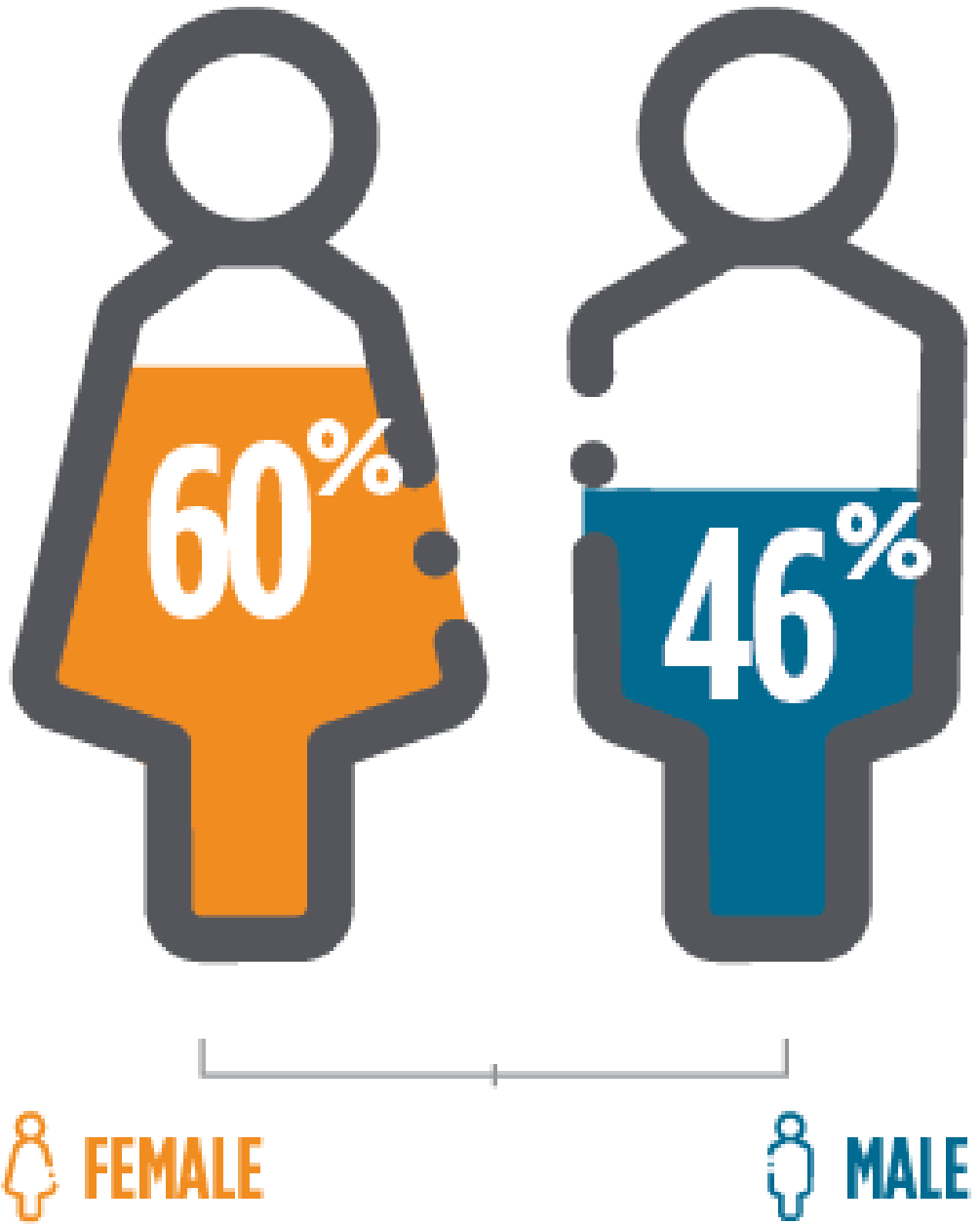
Across all races and ethnicities, women are more likely to go to college right after high school.

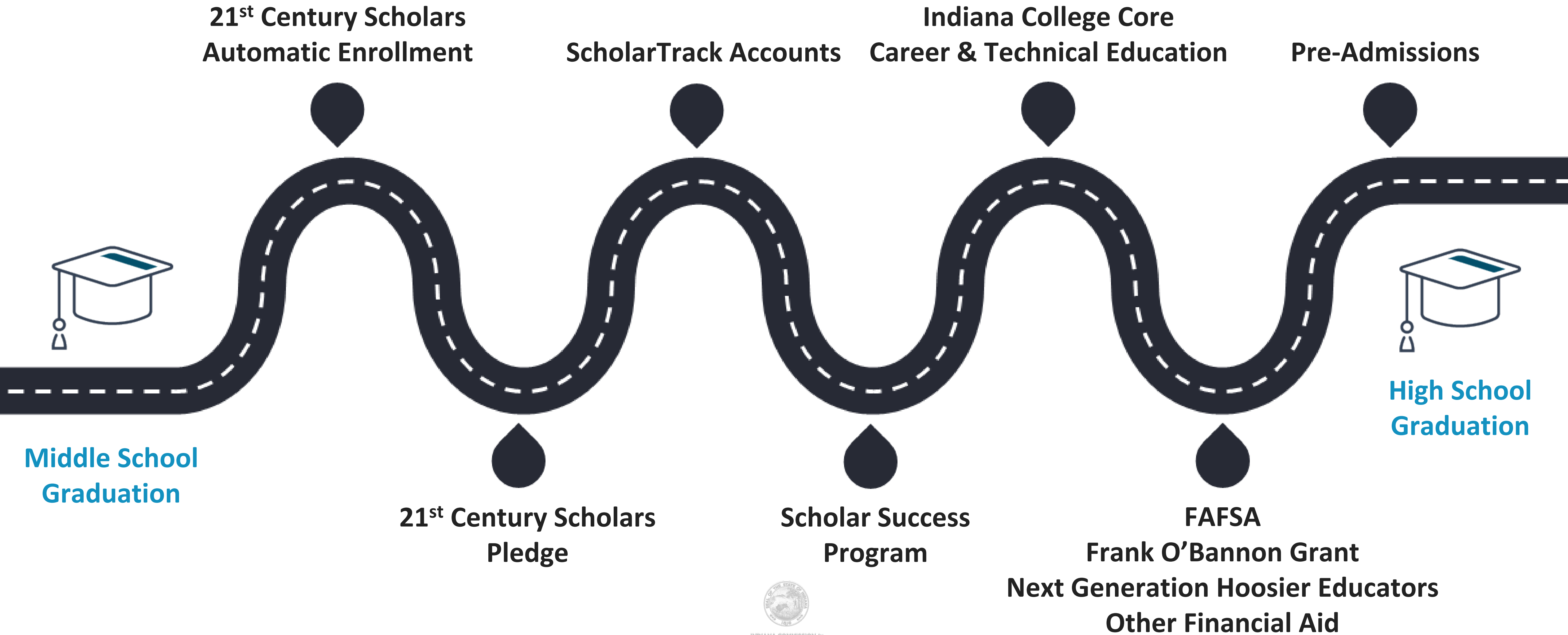
INDIANA PRE-ADMISSIONS

- The Commission has launched a pre-admission initiative **for the high school class of 2024**.
- High school seniors in 327 participating high schools have been notified of the up to 38 participating colleges and universities that they qualify for admittance.
- The Commission, in partnership with the institutions and the Indiana Department of Education, are using **high school GPAs and SAT scores** to inform students of their options.
- The Commission directs students to a landing page on Learn More Indiana's website that links to the Common App and/or each institution's admission processes and promotes FAFSA filing.

K-12 STRATEGY: HIGH SCHOOL



THREE MAIN OBJECTIVES

- ▶ To **inform** Indiana high school seniors about opportunities for postsecondary education available to them after graduation.
- ▶ To **assist** Indiana high school seniors in affording these postsecondary opportunities by providing various guides and resources as support.
- ▶ To **achieve** the CHE's goal of **providing access** to high-quality education or training for more than 60% of Indiana residents.



KEY POINTS & TERMINOLOGY

- ▶ Use the term ***pre-admissions*** not *direct admissions*.
 - ▶ This avoids confusion with existing campus direct admissions programs.
 - ▶ The *pre* in *pre-admissions* implies that there are next steps.
- ▶ Participating institutions have agreed to honor pre-admissions decisions, assuming students maintain eligibility criteria, meet any additional caveats (as applicable), and take the next steps to apply and enroll.
- ▶ The Commission defines *college* broadly. We want students and families to know about all their options.

2024 COHORT DATA BREAKDOWN

- ▶ Average Number of Decisions Per Student: 24 Campuses
 - ▶ 78% of eligible students received 4+ campuses (44,000+)
 - ▶ 77% of eligible students received 13+ campuses (43,000+)
 - ▶ 28% of eligible students received all 38 campuses (16,000+)

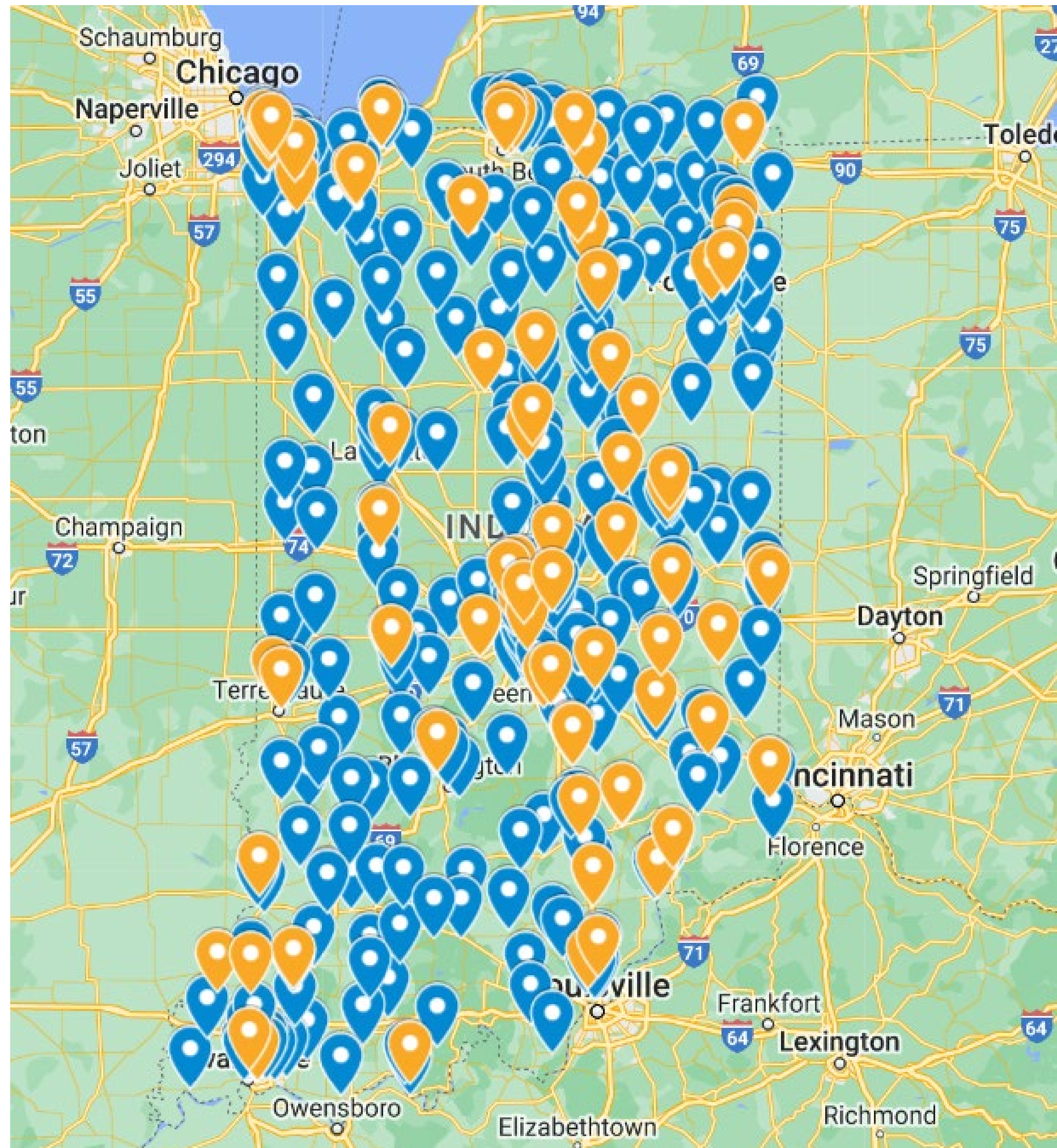

327 HIGH SCHOOLS OPT IN FOR CLASS OF 2024



- ▶ High schools opted in to participate.
- ▶ Participating high schools submitted end of junior year semester GPAs to ScholarTrack.
- ▶ The Commission received junior year SAT scores and updated addresses from the Department of Education.
- ▶ The Commission used ScholarTrack to match students to institutions based on GPA and/or SAT.

HOW YOU CAN SUPPORT STUDENTS

September 2023 – May 2024: Following the release of pre-admissions decisions to students and families.

- ▶ Assist students in creating, upgrading and updating ScholarTrack accounts.
- ▶ Meet with students to discuss their lists of pre-admitted colleges. Ensure they are comfortable with next steps and are familiar with the landing page.
- ▶ Encourage students and families to create FSA IDs to prepare to file the FAFSA.

December 2023 – April 2024: Following the release of the 2024-25 FAFSA.

- ▶ Partner with the Commission's K-12 Outreach team and INvestED on FSA ID creation and FAFSA filing.
- ▶ Ensure students and families file by April 15, 2024 to qualify for state financial aid.
- ▶ Help students monitor and meet institutional FAFSA deadlines to maximized financial aid opportunities.

Make sure that students monitor their new college e-mail once they accept an admissions offer!

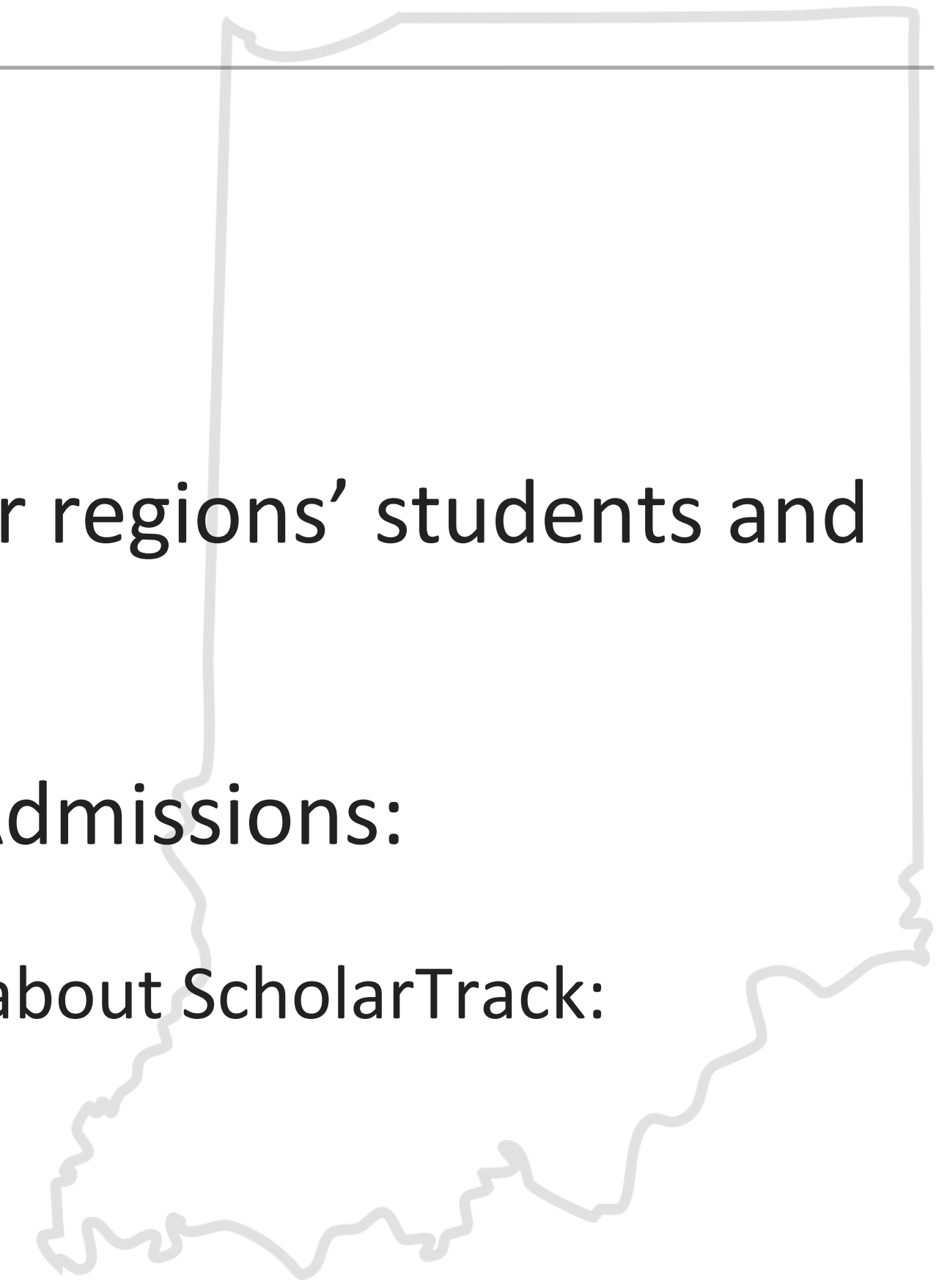
