HB 1511

▶ **HB 1511: Higher Education Scholarships, Grants, and Cost Exemptions** now allow recipients of the National Guard Supplement Grant and Tuition and Fee Remission Programs to use their award at private Indiana colleges and universities.

National Guard Supplemental Grant

- ▶ Students must be in active drilling status, cannot have been AWOL during prior year.
- ▶ Students must be certified by Guard Unit each semester.
- ▶ Must file FAFSA and submit the application **prior** to the start of classes.
- ▶ Covers up to \$5000 of tuition and regularly assessed fees;
 - ▶ *\$2500 is offered for the Fall and \$2500 is offered for the Spring.*
- ▶ Must be seeking Associate, first Bachelor's degree, or Master's degree.
- ▶ Must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).

National Guard Supplemental Grant

- ▶ Students can receive the grant for part-time or full-time enrollment.
- ▶ National Guard students must use Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) before receiving their NGSG. Any student who has not applied for FTA will receive a denied NGSG application.
- ▶ Any NGSG student EFC eligible for Frank O'Bannon Grant, will be able to receive the O'Bannon Grant instead as it offers the student a higher award amount.
- ▶ The NGSG is offered beyond 400 eligibility units. Students are eligible for 600 units (12 semesters) of NGSG.

TUITION AND FEE EXEMPTION FOR CHILDREN OF DISABLED VETERANS OR PURPLE HEART RECIPIENTS

Tuition and Fee Exemption Child of Disabled Veteran or Purple Heart Recipient

- ▶ Children of disabled Indiana veterans.
- ▶ Children of Purple Heart Recipients.
- ▶ Must file FAFSA and submit the application in ScholarTrack.
 - ▶ *Application is reviewed by IDVA*
 - ▶ *Student must provide birth certificate, DD214, and disability paperwork*
- ▶ Covers up to \$5000 of tuition and regularly assessed fees;
 - ▶ *Full amount can be claimed at once or broken up between terms.*
- ▶ Must be seeking degree-seeking.
- ▶ Must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).

Tuition and Fee Exemption Child of Disabled Veteran or Purple Heart Recipient

- ▶ Eligible students must have graduated high school *on January 1, 2023, or later*.
- ▶ Recipients who graduated before January 1, 2023, are not eligible to use the award at private, non-profit colleges, and universities.
- ▶ Students are awarded 124 credits to use. Once credit hours are exhausted, student is no longer eligible for their CVO award.
- ▶ Frank O'Bannon eligible students must have a claim against the O'Bannon Grant first, *THEN* a claim with the dollar amount and total enrolled credits on the CVO award.
 - ▶ Order of aid rules still apply
