







Indicator 3A: Child Outcomes - Positive Social Emotional Skills



SS1: Substantial Increase in Rate of Growth








Cluster Breakdown Indicator 3A SS2: Child Outcome Positive Social Emotional Skills - Within Age Expectations








Cluster Breakdown Indicator 3C SS1: Child Outcome Appropriate Behaviors to Meet Needs - Substantial Increase




Cluster Breakdown Indicator 3C SS2: Child Outcome Appropriate Behaviors to Meet Needs - Within Age Expectations



Cluster Breakdown Indicator 4A: Family Outcome Know Their Rights









Indicator 5: Child Find - % of Children Birth to Age 1 with IFSPs









Indicator 6: Child Find - % of Children Birth to Age 3 with IFSPs








Indicator 7: Timeliness of IFSPInitial evaluation, assessment, and IFSP within 45 days












