Distribution of Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account Funds

Overview

This report presents total state distributions of lottery and gaming revenues by county for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, as well as cumulative state distributions since the inception of the Hoosier Lottery in 1989. The General Assembly first enacted the law governing the use and distribution of lottery and gaming revenues in 1989 and amended it in 1990, 1991, 1993, 1995, 1997, and again in 1999. Public Law 25-1995 created the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account within the existing Build Indiana Fund, which was established by the 1989 Lottery Act. P.L. 25-1995 required that revenues from the Hoosier Lottery (after retirements and pension distributions), the riverboat gaming wagering tax, the horse racing pari-mutuel wagering tax, and from charity gaming taxes and license fees be deposited in the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account.

P.L. 25-1995 also set forth the uses of the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account revenues and provided for distribution priorities should the revenue from the various gaming sources fall short of appropriations. *Figure 1* illustrates both the sources of revenue and the "hierarchy" of distributions. The highest priority distribution is for motor vehicle excise tax replacement. If any lottery and gaming revenue remains available after these distributions, that revenue may be distributed for State and Local Capital Projects, the Indiana Technology Fund, the Indiana University Proton Therapy Center, the 21st Research and Technology Fund, and Indiana Public Television Grants.

In FY 2001, lottery and gaming revenues totaling \$395.1 million were transferred to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account from the following sources:

Hoosier Lottery	\$100.0 million *
Riverboat Gaming	\$260.2 million
Horse Racing	\$2.0 millio
Charity Gaming	\$6.0 million
Interest	\$26.9 million

^{* \$60.0} million of lottery revenues are transferred to the Teachers' Retirement Fund and the Local Police and Fire Pension Relief Fund prior to the required transfers to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account. Therefore, total Lottery revenues actually total \$160.0 million.

From 1989 through June 30, 2001, lottery and gaming revenues totaling \$3.081 billion were transferred to the State from the following sources:

Hoosier Lottery	\$1.936 billion
Riverboat Gaming	\$995.7 million
Horse Racing	\$15.3 million
Charity Gaming	\$33.7 million
Interest	\$100.6 million

Of the total \$3.081 billion of lottery and gaming revenues received by the State since 1989, \$2.632 billion has been distributed or committed as described in this report. The balance will be distributed on an ongoing basis in accordance with applicable law. *Figure 2* presents the distribution of Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account funds for FY 2001.

Sources and Uses of Revenue for FY 2001

Figure 1 depicts the appropriations, transfers, and distributions from the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account within the Build Indiana Fund, as enacted in P.L. 25-1995. As Figure 1 shows, after \$60 million of surplus lottery revenue is transferred from the Lottery Administrative Trust Fund to the Pension Relief Fund and the Teachers' Retirement Fund, the remaining surplus lottery revenue is transferred to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account within the Build Indiana Fund. In addition, the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account receives 75% of riverboat gaming wagering tax revenue, after an appropriation to the Indiana Gaming Commission for administrative expenses (the remaining 25% is distributed to local governments). And finally, the account receives interest income, horse racing pari-mutuel wagering tax revenue (except for \$150,000 which is first transferred to the Veterinary School Research Account and administrative expenses), and charity gaming excise tax and license fee revenue.

P.L. 25-1995 requires a transfer from the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account to the Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Replacement Account that is then allocated to the counties based on each county's share of motor vehicle registrations. Any surplus remaining in the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account after the distribution to the Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Replacement Account is then transferred to the State and Local Capital Projects Account. P.L. 260-1997 guaranteed that if funds in the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account are insufficient to make the distributions to the Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Replacement Account, the General Fund will make up the shortfall.

The total amount transferred to the State and Local Capital Projects Account is available to fund the following appropriations (P.L. 273-1999): the I.U. Proton Therapy Center, the Indiana Technology Fund, the 21st Century Research and Technology Fund, Indiana Public Television Grants and State and Local Capital Projects.

Historical Expenditure Detail

Table 1 presents the total amount of Build Indiana Fund projects that were approved by the Budget Committee in FY 2001 for each county. These project approvals may have received Build Indiana Fund appropriations by the General Assembly in either the current and previous fiscal years.

Table 2 and *Table 3* summarize category expenditures of lottery and gaming revenues for FY 2001 as well as cumulative expenditures since FY 1989. As a result of changes in the law, the uses

of lottery and gaming revenues have varied over time. The following notes provide greater detail concerning the categories of lottery and gaming revenue expenditures since FY 1989.

1. Excise Tax Relief. The 1990 Lottery Act amendments reduced automobile excise taxes, effective January 1, 1991. The 1991 Budget Act, however, suspended the excise tax replacement program effective December 31, 1991, after being in effect for one year. The replacement mechanism was instead used to calculate the amount that would be used for tuition support (See Note 2 below). Four years later, P.L. 25-1995 reduced automobile excise taxes by a maximum of 50% over six years. Funding to replace most, but not all, of the lost revenue was appropriated from the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account.

In 1996, P.L. 26-1996 accelerated the automobile excise tax rate reduction, thereby implementing the entire rate cut (50% maximum) in CY 1996. The revenue required to fund this acceleration was appropriated from the State General Fund.

In 1997, P.L. 260-1997 increased the amount of funding from the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account to replace most, but not all, of the revenue lost due to the rate reduction implemented in CY 1996. The total amount of funding from this account equals: \$139.5 million for CY 1996, \$155 million for CY 1997, \$180 million for CY 1998, \$206 million for CY 1999, \$233 million for CY 2000, and \$236 million for CY 2001 and each year thereafter.

- **2. Tuition Support.** The 1991 Budget Act suspended the excise tax relief program enacted in 1990 and instead dedicated the same amount of Hoosier Lottery profits that would have been utilized for excise tax relief to provide financial support for local schools. The 1991 Budget Act provided that these funds would be used to provide supplemental grants to each school corporation in the State in CY 1992 and CY 1993. The 1993 Budget Act provided these funds would be distributed as a part of the regular tuition support distribution in CY 1994 and CY 1995. The use of lottery revenue for tuition support was discontinued on June 30, 1995. For purposes of the county-by-county detail in *Table 3*, if a school corporation serves residents in more than one county, the amount of tuition support is shown only for the county of budget review.
- **3.** Teachers' Retirement Fund. The 1989 Lottery Act provided for annual appropriations of Hoosier Lottery profits to help offset the unfunded liability in the Indiana Teachers' Retirement Fund. The 1991 and 1993 Budget Acts redirected these appropriations to pay current teacher pensions in fiscal years 1992 through 1995. Beginning in FY 1996 and thereafter, the State will deposit lottery revenues into the Pension Stabilization Fund. The Pension Stabilization Fund is designed to reduce future state teacher pension expenditures. Because teacher pension payments are an obligation of the State and not local school corporations, it is not possible to allocate these lottery revenues by county. However, residents of each county benefit from this distribution. Current law requires a quarterly transfer from Lottery profits to the Pension Stabilization Fund of \$7.5

million, resulting in a \$30.0 million transfer each fiscal year. This transfer occurs before surplus lottery profits are transferred to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account.

- 4. Police and Fire Pensions. The 1989 Lottery Act provided that annually \$10.0 million of Hoosier Lottery profits would be used to offset the police and fire pension liabilities of cities and towns in Indiana. P.L. 273-1999 increased the transfer to police and fire pensions to \$30.0 million annually of Hoosier Lottery profits. The funds are distributed to individual communities each year in accordance with actuarial principles. Because police and fire pension payments are the responsibility of cities and towns, it is possible to calculate the benefit to each community of these distributions. The amount of police and pension relief, if any, shown in *Table 3* is the amount distributed from the Pension Relief Fund to the police and fire retirement accounts of communities in each county listed through June 30, 2001. In FY 2001, quarterly transfers of \$7.5 million from Lottery profits were transferred to the Pension Relief Fund resulting in a \$30.0 million transfer. As with the transfer to the Teachers' Retirement Fund, the transfer occurs before surplus lottery profits are transferred to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account.
- 5. Economic Development Grants. The 1990 Lottery Act amendments established the Job Creation and Economic Development (JCED) Account within the Build Indiana Fund for the purpose of supporting certain major economic development projects. A total of \$30.0 million of Hoosier Lottery profits was transferred to the JCED Account for this purpose, all of which has been distributed or obligated. The amount of economic development grants, if any, shown in *Table 3* is the amount of Hoosier Lottery profits committed by the State with respect to a specific project from the JCED Account and reviewed by the State Budget Committee.
- 6. Local Projects. The 1989 Lottery Act established the Build Indiana Fund, and the 1989 Budget Act appropriated \$86.2 million from the Build Indiana Fund for specific capital and construction projects. In 1990, the State and Local Projects Account was established within the Build Indiana Fund and an additional \$5.7 million was appropriated from this account for additional capital and construction projects. Further capital and construction project appropriations were made in 1991 (\$99.5 million), 1995 (\$46.3 million), 1997 (\$57.7 million), and 1999 (\$99 million). In addition to being appropriated, funding of state and local capital projects must be approved by the State Budget Committee. The amount of Build Indiana Fund Local Projects, if any, shown on *Table 3* represents amounts that were disbursed in FY 2001.
- 7. Indiana Technology Fund. P.L. 340-1995 created the Indiana Technology Fund and appropriated \$20.0 million in FY 1996 and \$20.0 million in FY 1997, from the Build Indiana Fund Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account to the Indiana Technology Fund to help schools and local libraries connect to the Internet and expand their technology capabilities. P.L. 260-1997 (ss) appropriated \$44.0 million for the FY 1997-1999 biennium and P.L. 273-1999 appropriated \$76.0 million for the FY 1999-2001 biennium. The \$38 million appropriation for FY 2001 provided for the following:

- \$1.0 million for the development of the State Backbone Project;
- \$3.0 million to the State Library and Historical Board for the INSPIRE Project;
- \$6.5 million to the Intelenet Commission to provide matching Internet connection grants to school corporations;
- \$27.5. million to school corporations under I.C. 20-10.1-25.3-1 for Technology Plan Grants

Actual distributions to local entities in FY 2001 are reflected in the following tables. In some cases, distributions made in FY 2001 include funds carried over from FY 2000. With respect to disbursements to schools and school corporations, disbursements are reflected by the county in which the school or school corporations' central office is located.

- 8. 21st Century Research and Technology Fund. P.L. 273-1999 and P.L. 190-1999 established the Indiana 21st Century Research and Technology Fund which provides grants and loans to support economic development. These projects include increasing the capacity of Indiana institutions of higher education, Indiana businesses, and Indiana nonprofit corporations to compete successfully for federal and private research funding. They also are intended to stimulate the transfer of research and technology into marketable products and to assist in diversifying Indiana's economy by focusing investment in biomedical research and biotechnology, information technology, and other high technology industry. The General Assembly appropriated \$50 million for the 1999-2001 biennium.
- **9. Digital Television Conversion for Indiana Public Television Stations.** P.L. 272-1999 established a \$20 million biennium appropriation for grants for digital conversion of public television. The Indiana Public Broadcasting Stations, Inc. must submit a distribution plan for the education television stations.
- **10. Indiana University-Proton Therapy.** P.L. 273-1999 appropriated \$10 million for FY 2001 and FY 20011 for Indiana University's Proton Therapy Center. This Center will allow for precise radiation treatment for certain kinds of cancer.
- 11. Local Road and Street Account Distribution. P.L. 340-1996 appropriated \$30.0 million in FY 1996 and FY 1997 from the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account for local roads and streets. It provided for the distribution of the appropriation in the same manner as the regular Motor Vehicle Highway Fund distribution to the Local Road and Street Account.
- 12. Unallocated Portions of Approved Funds. Certain categories of approved funds are approved by the Budget Committee prior to their allocation to specific projects or are not attributed to specific counties. In order to show these funds (that are "irrevocably committed"), several categories reflect funds which have been approved by the Budget Committee, but which have not yet been allocated to specific projects or counties. These unallocated amounts are shown among the "amounts not yet allocated" at the end of *Table 3*.

Riverboat Admission and Wagering Tax Distributions

Table 4 summarizes the total riverboat admission and wagering tax distributions for FY 2001 and the cumulative amount since FY 1996. *Tables 5* and 6 present these distributions as received by specific state and local units.

Table 5 shows the distribution of Riverboat Admission Tax to local units in FY 2001 and cumulative from FY 1996. The \$3 tax is paid by the organization that holds an owner's license for riverboat gambling operations and the tax is paid on admissions to riverboat gaming excursions. The tax is collected by the Department of Revenue and deposited in the State General Fund. The admission tax monies are distributed quarterly as follows:

- 1. In counties contiguous to Lake Michigan and counties along the Ohio River in which the riverboat is docked in the largest city in the county:
- \$1.00 to the city in which the boat is docked
- \$1.00 to the county in which the boat is docked
- \$.10 to the county convention and visitor bureau or promotion fund
- \$.15 to the State Fair Commission
- \$.10 to the Division of Mental Health
 - \$.65 to the Indiana Horse Racing Commission
- 2. In counties along the Ohio River in which the riverboat is NOT docked in the largest city in the county:
- \$2.00 to the county in which the boat is docked
- \$.10 to the county confession and visitor bureau or promotion fund
- \$.15 to the State Fair Commission
- \$.10 to the Division of Mental Health
- \$.65 to the Indiana Horse Racing Commission
- 3. In counties contiguous to Patoka Lake:
- \$1.00 distributed equally among the counties contiguous to the lake
- \$1.00 to the Patoka Lake Development Account
- \$.40 to the resource conservation and development program that serves the Patoka Lake area
- \$.50 to the General Fund
- \$.10 to the Division of Mental Health

Table 6 displays the Riverboat Wagering Tax distributions to local units in FY 2001 and cumulative since FY 1996. The tax is paid by an organization that holds an owner's license for riverboat gambling operations and is paid on 20% of adjusted gross receipts. The Department of Revenue deposits this tax revenue into the State Gaming Account and funds are then appropriated to the Indiana Gaming Commission for administrative expenses. 75% of the remaining tax revenue is distributed to the Lottery and Gaming Surplus Account within the Build Indiana Fund.

The remaining 25% is distributed as follows:

- In counties contiguous to Lake Michigan and counties along the Ohio River in which the riverboat is docked in the largest city in the county, funds are distributed to the city designated as the home dock
- In counties along the Ohio River in which the riverboat is NOT docked in the largest city in the county, the funds are distributed to the county in which the boat is docked
- In the counties contiguous to Patoka Lake, the funds are distributed in equal shares to each of these counties.

Figure 1 INDIANA LOTTERY AND GAMING SURPLUS ACCOUNT Sources and Uses for FY 2001

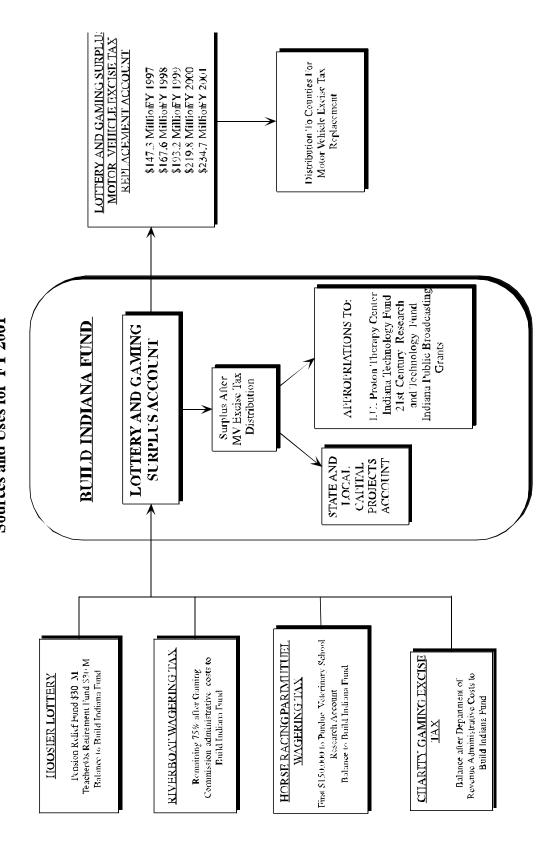

Fiscal Year 2001

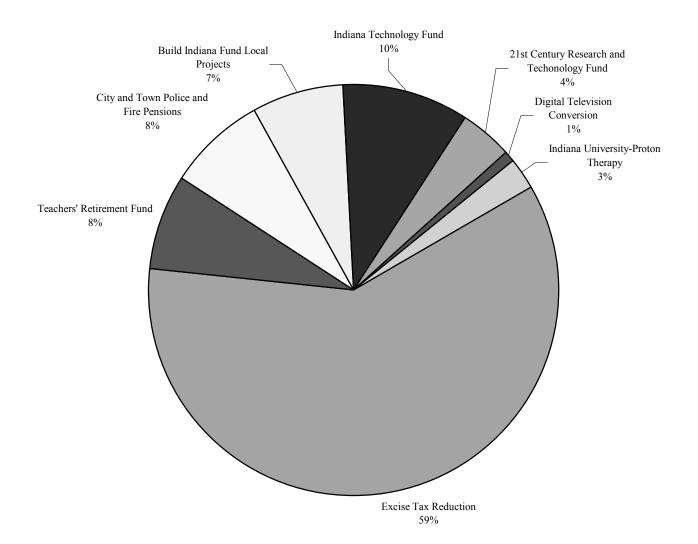
