The portion of the cigarette tax dedicated to the retiree health benefit plan is being redirected to the general fund for FY 2012 and FY 2013 only. These funds are being redirected to reimburse the General Fund for expenses incurred in prior years while ensuring the plan remains more than 100% actuarially funded.

- 2. Year-to-date revenues of motor vehicle excise taxes, commercial vehicle excise taxes, and financial institution taxes under HEA 1001-2008 totaled \$ 152.4 M. Due to the difficulty of determining the timing of these revenues, they are being deposited in a separate fund and will be reported as General Fund forecast revenue in June 2013.
