

When applying for an Indiana title for a new manufactured home, the following documents are required:

Certificate of Origin (C of O) or Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO). If the manufactured home was manufactured in more than one unit, the C of O/MSO is required for each unit. If a C of O/MSO cannot be provided, the purchaser must obtain a Court Order. Once the Court Order is issued, the purchaser must apply for title by submitting the Court Order Application Packet.
 Proof of Sales Tax Paid or Not Paid. If sales tax was paid to an Indiana dealer/non-dealer, a <u>Certification of Sales of</u>
Manufactured Homes or Industrial Building Systems (ST108MH) – State Form 35838 is required.
 If sales tax was not collected, or if the seller is an out-of-state dealer/non- dealer who collected the sales tax, a Bill of Sale or Purchase Agreement is required.
Power of Attorney (POA), if applicable. A copy of the POA documents and the appointed POA's driver license or identification card is required at time of application.
<u>Physical Inspection of a Vehicle or Watercraft – State Form 39530</u> - Must be completed by law enforcement.
A new manufactured home going into the name of a dealer licensed by the Indiana Secretary of State is excluded from this requirement.
 Mobile Home Permit – State Form 7878 - Must be completed by the County Treasurer. The permit cannot be accepted after its expiration date.
 The permit must bear an official seal from the County Treasurer.
 Since the seller is required to provide the buyer a mobile home permit at the time of purchase, the permit must list the seller as the owner.
For Established Indiana Residents: One proof of Indiana Residency. An Indiana driver's license or identification card may be accepted as proof if the address on the
credential is correct. If the address is not correct, any document from the approved BMV documentation list that is dated within the past 60 days may be used as proof. To view the approved BMV documentation list, click on the link provided or visit myBMV.com.
For New Indiana Residents/Out-of-State Residents: An Out-of-State Driver's License or Identification Card, Proof of Social Security Number, and Proof of Address. Proofs of address must be dated within the past 60 days. A list of acceptable proofs of Social Security Number and address is located on the approved BMV documentation list.
