Indiana Entry Requirements: Avian

All avian species entering Indiana must have:

A. NPIP Participant Flocks: Official NPIP paperwork with annual testing OR

B. A certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) issued within 30 days prior to entry.



AND

Meet the following testing requirements with a negative test within 30 days prior to entry:

Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Test Required

Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Stained-Antigen Rapid Whole Blood Test

Chickens Guinea Pheasant Quail Geese Ducks

Turkeys Partridge Grouse Peafowl Ratites

Swans

Mycoplasma Gallisepticum (MG)
Test Required

Exempt from Testing

Doves

House Birds

Pigeons
