- State driven, locally led



College GO! History

Indiana's College GO!

- Started in 2009 with a focus on high school students, later expanded to all K-12 students
- Officially kicks off the last week of September (25-29)



College GO! Goals

K-8 Students:


- Increase aspirations for higher education
- Support college and career exploration
- Encourage enrollment in 21st Century Scholars (7th/8th grade)

High School Students:

- 9th grade: Create a graduation plan
- 10th grade: Complete a career interest assessment
- 11th grade: Visit a college campus
- 12th grade: Apply to college



Scholar Success Program



College Application Day

- Started in 2004 in NC, expanded to all 50 states through an initiative with ACE (American Council on Education) called ACAC (American College Application Campaign)
- Goal: get more students, especially low-income and firstgeneration students, to apply to college
- New this year: states choose their own College Application Day
 - Indiana College Application Day: September 29



Previous Results

• **2013**: 8 participating schools

• **2014:** 36 participating schools

• **2015**: 41 participating schools

• **2016:** 30 participating schools

Goal for 2017: 45 participating schools



New This Year

Recap: FAFSA Filing

- The 2018-2019 FAFSA will be available to students on October 1, 2017
- Indiana FAFSA deadline moves to April 15
- Indiana removes May 15 edit/correction deadline
- Confusion still exists around FSA IDs



National #WhyApply Day

- National #WhyApply Day: September 22
- An initiative of ACE / ACAC
- Primary focus: getting education professionals to engage on social media
- Share reasons for applying to college across social media platforms



The 2017 College GO! and College Application Day Action Plan

College and High School Webinars

- The Commission hosted two webinars discussing 2017 updates and ideas
 - College and university partners (30 attended)
 - High school partners (39 attended)
- Participation ideas included:
 - Hold College GO! And College Application Day events
 - Coordinator events with local college campuses/high schools
 - Promote through earned/social media
 - Use College Application Day materials in the classroom



Events

- Encourage high schools, colleges and community organizations to host College GO! and College Application Day events for students to:
 - Complete college applications
 - Register for an FSA ID
 - Log into ScholarTrack to complete grade 12 activities (if Scholars)



College GO! Kick-off Event

- WHERE: (Tentative) Ben Davis High School
- WHEN: Friday, September 29
- PURPOSE: Get Ben Davis High School seniors to fill out college applications, create FSA IDs and/or complete Scholar Success Program activities



Event Collaboration

- Encourage high schools, colleges and community organizations to collaborate by:
 - College representatives as volunteers at events
 - Community collaboration to host events
 - Commission staff will assist in making connections as needed



Event Sign-Up

Schools planning to host an application event will sign up using an online form

- Schools who sign up will receive giveaways and recognition for hosting an event
- Better overall communication with host sites
- Capability for additional follow-up for data purposes



Social Media

- Encourage partners to promote College GO! and College Application Day by:
 - Sending press releases
 - Hosting media events within the community
 - Promoting an engaging with Commission social media (Facebook, Instagram and Twitter)
