Tracking your progress toward earning your 21st Century Scholarship is simple! Scholar-Track will guide you through the Scholar Success Program—required activities you must complete each year of high school to help you prepare for college and career success. Once you graduate, you'll use ScholarTrack to keep track of your state financial aid information.

You must use ScholarTrack to confirm completion of all required activities before June 30 of your senior year of high school to remain eligible for your Scholarship.
