- Nearly 350 conference attendees represented 68 unique Indiana institutions and community-based organizations
- Delivered 30 breakout sessions that engaged 71 presenters from over 20 different institutions and partner organizations
- **15** campus and community-based programs were represented during the Best Practices Showcase

- Three \$5,000 grants will be distributed to campuses with proven practices that support student success on their campus.
- Priority will be given to strategies that:
 - Engage multiple partnerships,
 - Easily replicated and scalable, and
 - Demonstrate proven results.

- Funds may be used to create and implement new programs or expand already established programs.
- Selected campuses will present their student success models at the 2017 Student Advocates Conference and prepare a final report on or before May 31, 2018.
