

CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS

Capital project funds account for financial resources to be used by the state for the acquisition or construction of major capital facilities (other than those financed by proprietary funds and trust funds).

Post War Construction Fund - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance of penal, benevolent and charitable institutions of the state.

Build Indiana Fund - This fund accounts for construction projects in local government as authorized by the State Budget Committee.

Soldiers and Sailors Children's Home Fund - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance for this state institution.

Veterans Home Fund - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance for the Indiana Veterans Home.

State Police Building Commission Fund - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance for this state commission.

Law Enforcement Academy Building Fund - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance for this state commission.

Interstate Bridge Fund - This fund is used to pay for studies and other costs pertinent to the design, construction, or purchase of interstate bridges.

Major Construction - Indiana Army National Guard - This fund accounts for new construction, rehabilitation and preventative maintenance for Indiana Army National Guard Posts.

Indiana Transportation Finance Authority – Highway Revenue Bonds – This fund accounts for the bond proceeds used for highway construction and improvement projects.
