i. APPROVAL OF MINUTES-

ii. <u>DIRECTORS REPORTS-</u>

A. Indiana Department of Homeland Security/District Four Updates

New IDHS district liaison Amy Bloom has decided to resume out district EM meetings. Quarterly opposite District 4 meetings. The plan is to resume these meetings beginning later this month.

B. Grants & Billing

We were award the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant through IDHS of \$20,000. Both County Council and County Commissioners have approved acceptance. We are awaiting final grant paperwork to be issued before putting out an RFP for the hazard mitigation plan. We are still waiting (8/2/2022) on the Federal Emergency Management Agency Covid PA grant of \$5,620.00. IDHS has received the money but has not issued the check yet.



C. Training & Exercise Activity

Hazmat Technician class began January 23rd 2023
Pipeline class is being held March 11th 2023.
800 radio classes have been scheduled through IPSC for Tuesday
February 7th 2023 at the Logansport Central Fire Station. The first class
will be at 2pm and then repeated again at 5pm. The LEPC annual
exercise process has begun. Planning meeting will be held February 10th
and 17th 10am at the EMA office. The tabletop exercise will be held
February 24th 2023 at the Salvation Army Building for community
partners. The full-scale hands-on exercise will be held on February 28th
2023. We are looking into purchasing a propane flaring kit. The LEPC has
approved to purchase the kit itself at \$1794.00. We are asking approval to
spend Non-Reverting funds to cover the \$3500.00 expense of training
county responders on the new equipment. A motion to approve covering
the cost of class was made by T.Williamson and seconded by
D.McDonald. Motion carries with all in favor, and none opposed.

iii. OLD BUSINESS-

A. Backup 911 Communications Center Project

No work is currently being done as the county prepares to move from the VHF system to the statewide 800 system.

B. County Fire Radio Project

ERS has procession of all the 800-radio equipment for the county. We are waiting on IPSC to assign channels and radio IDs. We provided the radio alias for entire county this week to ERS. We have a meeting with IPSC and ERS tomorrow to hopefully discuss radio talk groups and finalization.
