- 1) Welcome
- 2) Review of Community Partners (Bauer report out)
  - Currently 236 cases for Community Partners in Region 5
  - Close to 100% of Community Partners cases are free from abuse or neglect in the counties in Region 5
  - RFPs have been released for some proposals.
  - Benton County no longer in Region 5, however Community Partners (Bauer) will serve the county until the expiration of the contracts.
  - LODs may be reaching out for education on CP programming to make sure utilization is strong and understood within current assessment and permanency staff.
  - Safe Sleep contractor information will be sent to Regional Manager from Cassie Wade (Bauer) to share with staff for possible educational referrals.
- 3) Practice Indicators
  - Length of stay and kinship numbers discussed.

• Length of case and stay in out of home care will be monitored monthly in the LOD meeting and strategies shared with RSC for feedback and suggestion.

## 4) Budget Report

• As a Region, we are at 24.1%. Some increase in residential costs. Tippecanoe went over a little bit but doing fairly well and on target.

### 5) Services

- There is still no concrete date for RFP release.
- Day treatment and day reporting are being separated as a service standard to make sure that probation kids are getting therapeutic services during their time in the service.
