I have used the maximum tax rate provided by the School Corporation of \$0.10.

I have determined that the following percentages should be included in the form of the question provided by the School Corporation:

- A. Original estimated average percentage of property tax increase on a residence of __28.16_%, and
- B. Original estimated average percentage of property tax increase on a business of ___17.28_%.
