April 8, 2024

Thank you for considering experiencing the total solar eclipse at Blue Grass Fish & Wildlife Area. Keep this information in mind to ensure that everyone is safe and has a great experience during this rare solar eclipse event.

- Plan to travel to the property early and expect delays when leaving. Heavy traffic is expected after the eclipse. Bring snacks and water with you. Ensure you have enough fuel for safe travel home.
- It is important to keep roadways clear while enjoying the eclipse to ensure safe passage of emergency vehicles.
- Parking is limited to designated areas only. Parking on the grass is prohibited. You are welcome to park in any of the designated areas and walk around the property.
- Boating and kayaking will be allowed during the eclipse. Please be extra cautious during the period of darkness and use appropriate lighting.
- It is important to wear eclipse glasses while viewing the solar eclipse.
- Please remember to sign in at any of the self-service booths.
