- 1. All hunters must return a one-day hunt permit card regardless of success.
- 2. Shot shell limit is 25. Non-toxic shot required, maximum shot size: T.
- 3. For season dates, daily bag limits, and shooting hours, see the current Waterfowl Seasons and Regulations online at **hunting.IN.gov** or in the current Hunting & Trapping Guide.

HUNTERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE HIP PROGRAM

DRAWINGS FOR WATERFOWL HUNTING WILL ONLY BE HELD ON WEEKENDS. DURING THE WEEK, HUNTERS WILL USE THE SELF SERVICE CHECK-IN.

(No drawing for the Light Goose Conservation Order. Self Service Check-In.)

- 4. Drawing time: 6:00 a.m. ET.
- 5. Drawing will be by computer-run random number sheets.
- 6. Party size: 2 or 3. Singles will be considered after the drawing.
- 7. If drawn, parties may choose from available marsh areas.
- 8. Ducks and geese may be hunted in the following marsh areas:

Pisgah Lake, Furnas Fen, Teal Marsh, Beaver Bottom, Stone Arch Lake, Mallard Marsh, Mink Meadow Marsh, Possum Puddle, and Mauxferry Marsh.

Maximum numbers of hunters per marsh:

Pisgah – 15 Stone Arch – 6 Beaver Bottom – 3 Furnas Fen – 3 Teal Marsh – 3 Possum Puddle – 3 Mink Meadow – 3 Mallard Marsh – 3 Mauxferry Marsh – 3

9. The waterfowl resting area, which includes Coyote Marsh and Honker Haven, is a restricted use area (no hunting, fishing, or trespassing) closed from the end of August to the end of Waterfowl Season.

Beaver Bottom, Teal Marsh, Mallard Marsh, Mink Meadow, and Possum Puddle are closed to fishing during waterfowl season.

Pisgah Lake and Stone Arch Lake are open to fishing year around.
