2020 Indiana Forest Action Plan

- 1.) Conserve, manage and protect existing forests, especially large forest patches, with increased emphasis on oak regeneration
- 2.) Restore, expand and connect forests, especially in riparian areas
- 3.) Connect people to forests, especially children and land-use decision makers, and coordinate education training and technical assistance
- 4.) Maintain and expand markets for Indiana hardwoods, with special focus on secondary processors and promoting the environmental benefits of wood products to local communities and school groups
- 5.) Significantly increase the size of Indiana's urban forest canopy by developing community assistance programs and tools
