


Indiana Demonstration Forests

Working Woods for Production and Leisure

All of Indiana's citizens have a stake in the health and productivity of our forests. To sustain the growth and vigor of Indiana's forest resource, public understanding of scientific forest management is essential. The Indiana Division of Forestry is partnering with the Indiana State Department of Agriculture, the Indiana Forestry and Woodland Owners Association, and private landowners who demonstrate exemplary forest management practices to develop the Indiana Demonstration Forest program. With the assistance of foresters and other natural resource professionals, we believe landowners teaching and sharing their experiences with other landowners will lead to the scientific management of many more forested acres throughout Indiana.



Primary objectives of the Indiana Demonstration Forests

The primary objectives of the Indiana Demonstration Forest program are to provide working models for cooperative and innovative forest management, and to assist in networking landowners interested in improving and/or diversifying their forest management practices. Through Demonstration Forests, landowners will have opportunities to interact with foresters, wildlife biologists, researchers and other landowners, enhancing their skills and knowledge of forest management.
