The LWCF Closeout map is specific to the project area. It <u>must</u> contain:

- 1) Official park/site name.
- 2) Location/complete address.
- 3) County, Township, Range, and Section number.
- 4) Latitude/Longitude points of park entrance(s).
- 5) Name of person/agency preparing the map.
- 6) Date.
- 7) LWCF Project Number.
 - a. Past LWCF Project Numbers (if known).
- 8) Total acreage of existing park.
- 9) ASLO signatory with date DNR will add.
- 10) North arrow.
- 11) Map Legend.
- 12) Map Scale.
- 13) LWCF project boundary.
- 14) Identify all acquired properties (if applicable).
 - a. Delineate newly encumbered from previously encumbered acres.
- 15) Type and Location of Fund assisted facilities.
- 16)) Identify any existing facilities that were not included in the LWCF encumbrance.
 - a. Structures.
 - b. Park Roads.
 - c. Parking Lots.
 - d. Recreation activity areas (ball fields, picnic areas, etc.).
 - e. Enclosed structures/buildings.

Avoid use of color as the only means to delineate areas. Translucent shaded or hashed overlays are acceptable. Dashed lines for border delineation are acceptable.
