


Note:

The Revised Preliminary Zone A shown on this map for Heritage Lake is the floodplain that will be included on the final Flood Insurance Rate Map for Putnam County. This represents the limit of the 1% annual chance flood elevation for the lake, and the mandatory flood insurance purchase requirement would apply to structures located within this zone.

The shaded area shown as "top of dam" represents the area between the 1% annual chance flood and the top of dam. The top of dam elevation is the elevation the lake would reach where the water surface elevation would be just shy of overtopping the dam. Even though this elevation is above the recognized 1% annual chance flood elevation, floods exceeding the 1% annual chance have occurred in Indiana, and therefore structures in this shaded area do have a risk for flooding. While the mandatory flood insurance requirement would not apply to structures in this zone, flood insurance is recommended. This zone will not appear on the Flood Insurance Rate Map for Putnam County, and is shown here for informational purposes only.
