Biography

The Honorable Mark W. Everson served as Commissioner of The Internal Revenue Service from 2003 until 2007. Prior to joining the IRS, Everson held Bush administration posts as Deputy Director for Management for the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and Controller of the Office of Federal Financial Management. Everson also served in the Reagan administration, holding several positions at the United States Information Agency and the Department of Justice. In the private sector, he served as Group Vice President of Finance at SC International Services, Inc., a \$2 billion food services company, and as an executive with the Pechiney Group, one of France's largest industrial groups.

Everson is currently the Vice Chairman of alliantgroup, a leading provider of specialty tax services for small and medium sized businesses.

Everson received a bachelor's degree from Yale University, and a master's degree in accounting from New York University Business School.
