

## Passenger and Household Goods Checklist

If you transport passengers or household goods for hire, you must:
Apply for Indiana operating authority. Because there are three types of operating authority (permanent, temporary, and
emergency), you'll need to review the options, requirements, and applications found at www.in.gov/dor/4211.htm
Pay the annual fee.
File your annual reports by April 30.
Keep your insurance up-to-date.
