Solicitation Release Date: May 3, 2021

Grant Period of Performance: July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022



The Indiana Department of Veterans Affairs is seeking applications for the Grants for Veterans Services program. This solicitation is open to non-profit organizations registered with the Indiana Secretary of State.

The grant amounts will be between \$25,000 and \$150,000 depending on each applicant's need for funds, the availability of funding, and volume of eligible applicants.

All applications, procedures, and documentation should follow Indiana Code, Indiana Administrative Code, and Indiana Department of Veterans Affairs policies.





They can play music, tell jokes, lead dance trains, show YouTube videos, answer questions via Wikipedia, make deliveries to residents, and more. Additionally, they can autonomously facilitate video chats with family and friends outside of IVH for our residents. Our recreation and restorative nursing teams are using them to enhance their resident engagement activities, and they've been a welcome fun, new interactive devices that are already making friends with our residents and staff members.
