As we enter Suicide Prevention Month, VA (in partnership with the Ad Council) has released a new public service announcement (<u>The Question :60 | Veteran Crisis Prevention | Ad Council - YouTube</u>) as a part of the ongoing national campaign, "Don't Wait. Reach Out." To encourage Veterans to do for themselves what they would do for others, the new materials pose the simple question: "When was the last time you asked for help?"

PACT Act Special

Healthcare Enrollment





Between now and September 30, 2023, Veterans who deployed to a combat zone, never enrolled in VA health care, and left active duty between September 11, 2001 and October 1, 2013 are eligible to enroll directly in VA health care –without first applying for VA benefits. Veterans can <u>apply online</u> or in person at their <u>local VA facility</u> until 11:59pm local time on September 30, 2023.

Military Discharge:

Veterans separated under conditions other than Dishonorable are eligible for

Must have been eligible for retirement pay at time of death.

Active Duty Death:

Service members who die on active duty, in the line of duty

Surviving Spouse

The surviving spouse of an eligible veteran can be buried at the IVMC.

The Child of a Veteran:

Child must be under age 21 or permanent dependent of the
