Recommendations—Management

1. Organizational Management and Coordination

- Set up a structure and process for regular Adult Education/WorkOne staff interactions.
- Improve the referral process; increase referrals.
- Explore methods of providing shared access to the Adult Education InTERS student data system and WorkOne TrackOne case management system.
- Increase co-location.

Recommendations—Management

2. Program Staffing and Capacity Management

- Work with providers who have gaps between “physical capacity” and “instructional capacity” to expand system capacity.
- Consider weekend, off-hour, and workplace-based classes.

Recommendations—*Instructional Related Areas*

1. Curriculum and Instruction

Overall Recommendation:
Facilitate regional innovation and diversity but concur statewide on standards.

- Create a curriculum workgroup (standards in action workgroup) to identify the curriculum standards and evaluate curricula.
- Clarify policy on e-learning and distance learning—provide e-learning supports.
- ICE integration.



Recommendations—*Instructional Related Areas*

4. Transition to Post-Secondary and Employment

- Formalize the transition process
- Enhance supports for credential attainment
- Business engagement
- Development of contextualized workplace based Adult Education courses with businesses

Recommendations—*Instructional Related Areas*

6. WorkINDiana

- Clarify program design and intended outcomes
- Continue to improve the processes for student application and enrollment into WorkINDiana and the customer flow of the programs
- Standardize processes for monitoring/evaluating WorkINDiana
- Engaging employers and facilitating job placements
- Explore WorkINDiana at corrections facilities

Recommendations

Professional Development

- Offer more and more structured Professional Development.
- Steering committee and PD planning.
- Convene Director and Teacher Meetings.
- Develop New Teacher Handbook.
- Provide teacher mentoring.
- Annual or bi-annual conferences.

- Basic Grant and EL/Civics Competitions similar to 2012-2013 requirements
- Specific Changes
 - 3-year regional strategy/vision
 - Partnership agreements
 - Professional Development
- Tentative timeline
 - Release in early February
 - Deadline in early April

ABE

- Formula remains the same (40/10/50)
- Calculating enrollment and performance on 1.5 years
- Funding amounts uncertain

WorkINdiana

- Formula based on enrollments, need, and performance
- Performance will likely be defined as completions, certifications, and employment
- Funding amounts uncertain


EL Civics

Accuplacer Update

– Pricing

- Placement = \$1.55 per testing unit. Test is adaptive—a maximum of 4 units per student (\$6.20).
- Diagnostic=\$15 for 10 weeks of access per student (subject to change as determined by vendor)
