The **Department of Workforce Development (DWD)** and various stakeholders have adopted the following criteria to define a sector strategy as "a partnership of multiple employers within a critical industry that brings together education, economic development, workforce systems, and community organizations to identify and collaboratively meet the workforce needs of that industry within a regional labor market."


