WHEREAS, in accordance with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), Section 101, and Indiana Code 22-4-18.1-3, the State Workforce Innovation Council (SWIC) is established to accomplish certain enumerated functions; and

WHEREAS, the Act takes effect July 1, 2015, amends the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, and is meant to strengthen the United States workforce development system through innovation in, and alignment and improvement of, employment, training, and education programs in the United States, and to promote individual and national economic growth, and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, among the enumerated functions in the Act, the SWIC is responsible for assisting the Governor in the development, implementation, and modification of the State plan; and

WHEREAS, the state collaborated with stakeholders in the development of the plan, sought public comment, and updated the plan based on the public comment; and

WHEREAS, the State Plan is required to be submitted to the Departments of Labor and Education on March 3, 2016;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the SWIC approves the State Plan for submission to the Departments of Labor and Education.
