Resolution to Designate New Workforce Service Areas
September 13, 2012

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 Section 111(d), the State Workforce Innovation Council (SWIC), is established to accomplish certain enumerated functions; and

WHEREAS, among those functions includes the responsibility to make recommendation to the Governor regarding the designation of workforce service areas throughout the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the SWIC and the Governor received a request from the local elected officials of Region 9 to establish a local workforce service area, governed by a local workforce investment board; and

WHEREAS, the remaining three regions that comprise the Balance-of-State Workforce Service Area have been provided with the opportunity to comment on their interest in establishing local workforce service areas.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the SWIC, acting in its role as the State Workforce Investment Board, and fulfilling its duties as enumerated in the above cited code, hereby recommends newly establishing the following workforce service areas within the State of Indiana beginning July 1, 2013, and for those workforce service areas to take the necessary steps to transition from regional workforce areas to local workforce service areas, as defined in the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and pursuant to SWIC guidance:

Region 5 (Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Madison, Morgan, and Shelby counties)

Region 8 (Brown, Daviess, Greene, Lawrence, Martin, Monroe, Orange, and Owen counties)

Region 9 (Bartholomew, Dearborn, Decatur, Franklin,, Jackson, Jefferson, Jennings, Ohio, and Ripley counties)

Region 11 (Dubois, Gibson, Knox, Perry, Pike, Posey, Spencer, Vanderburgh, and Warrick counties).
