**Resolution to Recommend Governor Approve Local Consolidation of Workforce Investment Board,
One Stop Operator, and WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker Service Provider Duties for Region 2, 3,
and 6
June 26, 2012**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 Section 111(d) and Indiana Code 22-4-18.1-3, the State Workforce Innovation Council (SWIC), is established to accomplish certain enumerated functions; and

WHEREAS, among the duties enumerated in the above cited code, the SWIC assists the Governor in the development and continuous improvement of the statewide workforce investment system; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 established three levels of local program governance and operations –local workforce investment board, one stop operator, and service provider; and

WHEREAS, WIA Section 117(f) allows a local workforce investment board to also be designated as a one stop operator and to provide adult and dislocated worker services only with the agreement of the chief elected official and the Governor; and

WHEREAS, in DWD Policy 2010-12, entitled “Local Workforce Investment Board Staffing Guidance,” the State of Indiana provided a process whereby the Chief Elected Official for a local workforce service area and the local workforce investment board could request approval of the consolidation of the statutory functions of a local workforce investment board, its one stop operator, and WIA adult and dislocated worker service provider; and

WHEREAS, Regions 2, 3, and 6 have provided requests that cohere with the requirements of DWD Policy 2010-12; and

WHEREAS, Regions 2, 3, and 6 have received approval for their respective local workforce investment plans for Program Year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the SWIC Executive Committee is empowered by its bylaws to take action on behalf of the SWIC when lacking a quorum; and

WHEREAS, a quorum was not present at the June 21, 2012 meeting of the SWIC.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the SWIC, fulfilling its duties as enumerated in the above cited code, recommends that the Governor approves the consolidation of the statutory and regulatory duties of the local workforce investment board, the one stop operator, and WIA adult and dislocated worker service provider within Region 2, 3, and 6.


