Resolution to Develop a Policy Governing On-the-Job Training within the State and to Encourage the Usage of On-the-Job Training Services by Regional Workforce Boards and the Indianapolis Private Industry Council
September 17, 2009

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 Section 111(d) and Indiana Code 22-4-18.1-3, the State Workforce Innovation Council (SWIC), is established to accomplish certain enumerated duties; and

WHEREAS, includes among those enumerated duties are the development of a state-wide system of activities that are funded through the Workforce Investment Act or are carried out through a one-stop delivery system;

WHEREAS, on-the-job training, as defined in Section 101 (31) of the Workforce Investment Act, is an allowable training activity for Workforce Investment Act participants; and

WHEREAS, the SWIC recognizes the value of on-the-job training as a successful strategy for training and placing unemployed individuals;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the SWIC directs the Department of Workforce Development to develop and implement an on-the-job training policy that will define the permissions and limitations for on-the-job training services offered by Regional Workforce Boards and the Indianapolis Private Industry Council, and to provide technical assistance throughout the State on such a policy; and

IT IS ALSO RESOLVED, that the SWIC encourages the Regional Workforce Boards and the Indianapolis Private Industry Council to implement on-the-job training services and strategies through the usage of annual WIA funds.
