**Resolution to Set-Aside WIA State Funds for On-the-Job Training Activities
 September 17, 2009**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 Section 111(d) and Indiana Code 22-4-18.1-3, the State Workforce Innovation Council (SWIC), is established to accomplish certain enumerated duties; and

WHEREAS, includes among those enumerated duties are the development of a state-wide system of activities that are funded through the Workforce Investment Act or are carried out through a one-stop delivery system; and

WHEREAS, the SWIC is charged with overseeing the allocation and usage of funds reserved under Section 128 (a) and Section 133(a) of the Workforce Investment Act for state activities;

WHEREAS, on-the-job training, as defined in Section 101 (31) of the Workforce Investment Act, is an allowable training activity for Workforce Investment Act participants; and

WHEREAS, the SWIC recognizes the value of on-the-job training as a successful strategy for training and placing unemployed individuals;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the SWIC shall set aside a portion of the Program Year 2009 funds reserved for state activities to provide funding for on-the-job training activities, and that the allocation and usage of these State on-the-job training funds will be overseen by the SWIC Grants Committee.
