To Whom It May Concern:

St. Vincent Seton Specialty Hospital, Inc. hereby gives you notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 that it will permanently close its Seton Specialty Hospital, Inc. – Lafayette facility located at 1501 Hartford Street, Lafayette, Indiana. All affected employees have or will be provided with 60-days' written notice of their pending separation. Employment separations will occur on December 3, 2014. All positions and job titles at this location are being eliminated, affecting a total of eighty-three employees. There are no bumping rights applicable to employees terminated as a result of this closure. No separate union notification was necessary, as none of the affected employees are represented by a union. St. Vincent Seton Specialty Hospital, Inc. will be offering severance benefits to eligible employees to assist them in the transition from our employment. It will also provide priority consideration to displaced employees for other employment opportunities for which they are interested in and qualified.
