The Bureau of Quality Improvement Services is committed to supporting our provider network in working toward a true person-centered system which includes ensuring that individuals and those who support them honor individual rights and responsibilities.

As part of that commitment, and as announced previously on Feb. 14, 2022, BQIS is hosting a web-based training opportunity focused on behavior supports. We are pleased to be offering this in partnership with the Indiana Association of Behavior Consultants.

The presentation will cover what to expect from behavior supports, rights and modifications under the Home-and Community-Based Services Final Rule, and the role of the team in supporting the individual. This is the third in a series of trainings highlighting components of the HCBS Final Rule.

This opportunity is being provided at no cost to participants and is **mandatory** for all current Bureau of Developmental Disabilities Services home and community-based services providers. This means if your organization is a current BDDS service provider of **any** home-and community-based service, it is **required** that an executive level staff member of your organization attend this training. All others, including individuals with disabilities, program managers, direct support professionals, case managers and families are welcome to attend.
