The Bureau of Developmental Disabilities Services is committed to working collaboratively with case managers and providers during this continued public health emergency. We appreciate the hands-on and coordinated efforts and responses our case managers and providers have demonstrated. As part of this commitment, below are reminders on required COVID-19 reporting:

- Individuals receiving BDDS services and supports
 - COVID-19 positive cases (confirmed via a COVID-19 test) **and** all deaths must be reported via <u>BDDS online incident reporting system</u>.
- Provider staff in direct contact with individuals receiving BDDS services and supports
 - COVID-19 positive cases (confirmed via a COVID-19 test) **and** all COVID-19 related deaths must be reported via online at <u>COVID-19 employee reporting form</u>.
- Provider notification of temporary closures or re-opening
 - Temporary closures or re-opening must be reported online at <u>Provider notification of</u> temporary closures or re-opening.
