1	Advocacy & Engagement	The individual was actively engaged, to the greatest extent possible, in a person- centered assessment process.
2	Advocacy & Engagement	The assessment reflects what is important to the individual as it relates to their interests, strengths and needs and supports their vision for a good life.
3	Advocacy & Engagement	The assessments were used to develop and drive changes to the plan (including outcomes, strategies, community activities and integrated supports) as needed.
4	Advocacy & Engagement	The individual is receiving the services they want or need to meet their personal goals and live the life they choose.
5	Advocacy & Engagement	The individual has the information needed to make decisions regarding what services are available to support them in achieving their outcomes.
6	Community Living	The individual is provided with support to make an informed choice regarding community based non-waiver services.
7	Community Living	The individual's owned, rented, or occupied dwelling/unit is under a legally enforceable agreement.
8	Safety & Security	The individual has the same responsibilities/protections from eviction as all tenants under landlord tenant law of state, county, city or other designated entity.
9	Daily Life & Employment	The individual has the freedom and support to control their own schedules and activities.
10	Advocacy & Engagement	The individual chooses the people who work with them.
11	Advocacy & Engagement	The individual has privacy in their sleeping or living quarters.
12	Safety & Security	The individual's living quarters has lockable entrance doors, with the individual and appropriate staff having keys to doors as needed.
13	Community Living	The individual shares living quarters and has a choice of roommates.
14	Community Living	The individual has the freedom to furnish and decorate their sleeping or living quarters within the lease or other agreement.
15	Community Living	The setting is physically accessible to the individual.
