

# Medicare Eligible Members

Beneficiaries who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid and have income below 100 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL) are eligible for full ABD Medicaid benefits (shown in green below). Beneficiaries who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid and have incomes between 100 and 185 percent of the FPL qualify for a Medicare Savings Program (MSP). If the individual's household income falls between 100 and 150 percent of the FPL (shown in yellow below), he or she will be eligible for a program that provides coverage for Part B Medicare premiums, the annual Part A and B deductibles and Medicare copayments and coinsurance. Individuals with incomes between 150 and 185 percent FPL (shown in purple below) will be eligible for and automatically enrolled in a program where Medicaid pays Part B Medicare premiums. These members will continue to receive coverage for their Medicare Part B premiums but will no longer be eligible to spend down to receive coverage for Medicare cost-sharing and services not covered by Medicare. Individuals with household income above 185 percent of the FPL should contact the State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) to learn about their options to purchase a Medigap or Medicare Advantage policy. An individual with income above 185 percent FPL will not qualify for any Medicaid benefits unless he or she is eligible for institutional or home and community based waiver services or the Behavioral and Primary Healthcare Coordination program.
