

SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE (SACC) REQUEST FOR FUNDS (RFF)

The Office of Early Childhood and Out of School Learning will begin to take applications for the School Age Child Care (SACC) Request for Funds (RFF)

PURPOSE OF GRANT

- To support a school age child care program which offers care to children between the ages of 5 to 15 to include;
 - Before and/or after school care
 - Periods when school is not in session excluding summer break
 - Care for children that attend kindergarten – either full or half day kindergarten
 - Care for children that are enrolled in summer school

- Funds will be available to be used for program enrichment, staffing, equipment and staff development.

To be considered for these grants, all proposals must be submitted by close of business, 5:00p.m. **December 11, 2015. Late submissions will not be accepted.** Respondents must submit proposals in one of two ways, 1.) 1 disc in PDF format plus five (5) single sided copies of the application and necessary attachments or 2.) Electronic submission by email to Linda Kolbus at Linda.Kolbus@fssa.in.gov, respondents are responsible to confirm State receipt of the proposal.
