Hi Brian,

I am sending you this message to confirm that the Indiana State Department of Health has conducted the family impact assessment required by Executive Order 13-05. Thus far in 2013, the ISDH has engaged in rulemaking activities regarding five proposed rules:

- (1) LSA #12-617 (Trauma registry rule)
- (2) LSA #12-616 (Commercial on-site sewage systems rule)
- (3) LSA #12-615 (Residential on-site sewage systems rule)
- (4) LSA #12-501 (Health care professional recruitment and retention program)
- (5) LSA #12-431 (On farm poultry processor exemption rule)

Proposed rules (1), (2) and (3) are presently in the rulemaking process. Proposed rules (4) and (5) completed the rulemaking process and became effective on 5/30/13 and 3/16/13, respectively.

The ISDH assessed each of these proposed rules in light of the questions contained in section 2(a) - (f) of Executive Order 13-05. The ISDH concluded that none of them has a real or potential impact on family well-being or family formation.
