Technical Notes: Reported cases of acute hepatitis B must meet the following clinical and laboratory criteria:

Clinical: An acute illness with a) discrete onset of symptoms and b) jaundice or elevated serum aminotransferase levels.

Laboratory: IgM antibody to hepatitis B core antigen (anti-HBc) positive or hepatitis B surface antigen (HbsAg) positive. IgM anti-HAV negative (if done).

Note: Data is suppressed (S) when counts are < 5 or if determined identifiable, by having a corresponding column found to be <5.
