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## HIV OUTBREAK RESPONSE UPDATE

INDIANAPOLIS—State health officials announced today that the number of HIV cases in the southeastern Indiana outbreak is now at 169 cases (166 confirmed and three preliminary positive).

All state services will now be offered once a week, on Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., at the Austin Community Outreach Center. This includes access to state-issued ID cards, birth certificates, job counseling and local training, enrollment in HIP 2.0 insurance, HIV testing, HIV care coordination, substance abuse referrals, and vaccinations against tetanus, Hepatitis A and B.

Clinical services currently being provided at the Community Outreach Center will continue to be offered on Wednesdays as well.

The Scott County Health Department will continue to operate their Needle Exchange Program and offer HIV testing services at the Community Outreach Center. Hours of operation are 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. On Tuesday and Thursday, visitors who need access to state services will be provided information and transportation to the local service location for the agency.
