

Registration Checklist

Welcome to the Indiana Thoroughbred Breed Development Program! You are about to be a part of one of the most lucrative regional breeding programs in the nation.

To help make the registration of your Indiana-bred easier, follow this checklist to insure that you've followed through with all the requirements in order to run for our Breed Development Program Incentives.

M	ARES
	November 1 – Mare must enter Indiana by November 1 in the year prior to foaling and remain in
	Indiana continuously until foaling.
	Register the mare with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission by
	November 1 in the year prior to foaling.
	After November 1 – If your mare enters Indiana after November 1 in the year prior to foaling, she
	must remain in the state until foaling.
	Mare must be registered with the IHRC within 10 days of foaling.
	Mare and foal must remain in Indiana for 30 days after foaling.
	Mare must be bred back to a registered Indiana stallion after foaling.

* If	you move your mare during the required residency timeframe, you must notify the IHRC.
	Submit a <u>Change of Residency</u> form either <u>online</u> or by downloading the form
	(https://forms.in.gov/Download.aspx?id=10996) & mailing it in.
	Mare applications must be completed annually.
FOALS	
	Foals must be registered within the <i>first year</i> of the foaling date to be eligible for free
	registration.

	Late fee schedule is as follows:
	12 months + 1 day to December 31st of yearling year: \$200
	2 years old: \$400
	3 years old & older: \$1,000
* f	you move your foal during the required residency timeframe, you must notify the IHRC.
	Submit a <u>Change of Residency</u> form either <u>online</u> or by downloading the form

STALLIONS

	October 15 – Stallion must enter Indiana by October 15 in the year prior to breeding
	season. Stallions must remain in Indiana for the entire breeding season (February 1 through
	July 1).
	A late fee of \$250 will be assessed for late registration of any returning
	stallion.
	New stallions arriving late cannot have covered any mares in another state during the same
	year. The late fee (\$250) is waived for new stallions standing their first season in Indiana.
	An application must be filed every year the stallion breeds in the state of Indiana.

* If	you move your stallion during the required residency timeframe, you must notify the IHRC.
