ii. Oral Arguments

"The Administrative Law Judge's Order Disposing of the proceeding becomes a final order when affirmed under [IC 4-21.5-3-29]," which provides that "[a]fter an Administrative Law Judge issues an Order...the ultimate authority...shall issue a final order: (1) affirming; (2) modifying; or (3) dissolving; the administrative law judge's order. The ultimate authority...may remand the matter, with or without instructions, to an administrative law judge for further proceedings." Objections by a party and oral argument can inform the Commission's review of the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Generally, the Commission's "final order disposing of a proceeding or an order remanding an order to an administrative law judge for further proceedings shall be issued within sixty (60) days after...the close of oral argument." IC 4-21.5-3-27&29.

1. Erica Shannon v. Pedcor management Corporation, Princeton Lake Apartments, HOfs16101514.

After ICRC Director dismissed the complaint under the Indiana Fair Housing Act on 4/24/2017, but the ICRC later issued a Notice of Reversal stating that the dismissal had been "reversed" into a "finding of reasonable cause," the Administrative Law Judge dismissed proceedings under the Indiana Fair Housing Act. Neither Complainant (Shannon) nor Respondent filed objections; ICRC Director submitted objections.
