ii. Review of ALJ Decisions and Orders

"The Administrative Law Judge's Order Disposing of the proceeding becomes a final order when affirmed under [IC 4-21.5-3-29]." IC 4-21.5-3-27(a).

- 1. <u>Jordan v. 8 Seconds Salon, (ICRC No.: Paha19040234)</u>
 The ALJ dismissed case after both Parties requested the dismissal.
- 2. HE v. Belterra Casino, (ICRC No.: EMha13101544)
 After conducting a Hearing on the merits, the ALJ found
 Respondent discriminated against Complainant on the basis
 of disability but not on the basis of race and national origin.
 As a result, the ALJ awarded Complainant \$76,583.41 and
 ordered affirmative relief, including training and policy
 changes. The ALJ dismissed the race and national origin
 complaint. Both Complainant and Respondent have filed
 objections.
- 3. LYMON v. UAW Local Union #2209, United Automobile,
 Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America,
 [ICRC. No.: EMra12041133]

The ALJ dismissed the matter after a hearing on the merits. Complainant filed objections. Respondent filed a request for the Commission to affirm the ALJ's the Initial Order and filed bjections in the alternative.
