# RECOMMENDED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND DEFAULT ORDER

#### **JURISDICTION & PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The Commission of the Indiana Civil Rights Commission ("ICRC") has subject matter jurisdiction over employment discrimination complaints based on disability that are filed under the Indiana Civil Rights Law ("ICRL"). IND. CODE § 22-9-1-2; IND. CODE § 22-9-1-6. On July 16, 2021, the ICRC, after conducting a neutral investigation, made a probable cause finding on Jennifer Marcum's February 27, 2020 complaint that alleged Respondent violated the Indiana Civil Rights Law ("ICRL") by discriminating against her in the protected area of employment on the basis of disability. When a finding of cause is made under the ICRL, pursuant to the Commission's June 19, 2020 Finding of Necessity, the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") shall appoint an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") to preside over the matter and to conduct a hearing. IND. CODE § 22-9-1-6; IND. CODE § 4-15-10.5-12; IND. CODE § 4-15-10.5-13. On June 24, 2022, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings issued a Notice of Proposed Default Order, to which a response was not filed. Accordingly, the undersigned ALJ hereby enters the following Default Order based on the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The ICRC issued a Notice of Finding in this matter on July 16, 2021. However, the ICRC did not send the matter to the OALP until February 3, 2022.
- 2. On February 18, 2022, the undersigned ALJ conducted an Initial Prehearing Conference during which concerns about Respondent's status as a business entity were raised by Respondent's former attorney. Specifically, Respondent's former attorney represented that

- Respondent had completed insolvency proceedings. Complainant requested 30 days to investigate the issue.
- 3. On March 22, 2022, the undersigned ALJ conducted a second Prehearing Conference. Complainant represented that Complainant needed additional time to research Respondent's status.
- 4. In the resulting March 23, 2022 Second Prehearing Conference Order ("Notice"), the undersigned ALJ scheduled a telephonic Prehearing Conference for May 9, 2022 at 1:00 PM.
- 5. On May 9, 2022, the undersigned ALJ conducted a third Prehearing Conference, at which Complainant did not appear.
- 6. In the resulting May 17, 2022 Third Prehearing Conference Order, the undersigned ALJ set a June 6, 2022 deadline for Complainant to file a brief on Complainant's position concerning Respondent's status and Complainant's position on how this matter will proceed in light of the concerns with service of the Notice of Finding.
- 7. Complainant did not file a brief by June 6, 2022.
- 8. The undersigned ALJ did not receive a motion to continue the May 9, 2022 Prehearing Conference or the June 6, 2022 briefing deadline, and the undersigned ALJ has not received any information that would indicate that service of the relevant orders was not perfected on Complainant.
- 9. On June 24, 2022, the undersigned ALI issued a Notice of Proposed Default Order that include an advisory on the seven (7) day deadline for filing a response and the consequences of failing to file a response. No response was filed.
- 10. Any Conclusion of Law that should have been deemed a Finding of Fact is hereby adopted as such, and the procedural history is hereby incorporated by reference.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Under Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24, a Party may be defaulted when a Party fails to "...attend or participate in a prehearing conference, hearing, or other stage of the proceeding." IND. CODE § 4-21.5-3-24(a)(3).
- 2. Complainant failed to attend a properly noticed prehearing conference in this matter, and accordingly, the defaulting of Complainant is appropriate pursuant to Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24. Further, Complainant has not indicated a willingness to participate in this matter, as reflected by Complainant's lack of response to the June 6, 2022 briefing deadline. As a result, the undersigned ALI issued a Notice of Proposed Default Order as required by Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24.
- 3. Petitioner did not file any response to the Notice of Proposed Default Order, and accordingly, the undersigned ALJ hereby issues this Default Order. IND. CODE § 4-21.5-3-24(c).

4. Any Finding of Fact that should have been deemed a Conclusion of Law is hereby adopted as such.

#### **ORDER**

Having carefully considered all of the foregoing and being duly advised in the premises, the undersigned ALI hereby orders as follows:

- 1. Complainant is defaulted.
- 2. Jennifer Marcum's February 27, 2020 complaint of discrimination is dismissed, with prejudice.

This order is not final until affirmed by the Indiana Civil Rights Commission.
