DESCRIPTION OF SOURCE:

The source manufactures structural clay pipe and flue.

BACKGROUND:

I inspected Can Clay on January 25, 2019 where Mr. Lewis stated they would not be operating until March 2019. I received a phone call from Mr. Lewis on March 27, informing me that Can Clay Corporation is closing and the last day of production was March 4. I called Mr. Lewis on April 10 to make sure he was on-site for a walkthrough on April 11.

PROCESS DESCRIPTION/FINDINGS/OBSERVATIONS:

I did not observe any equipment in operation during my inspection. I observed workers in the process of removing the equipment so it can be sold. Mr. Lewis gave me a tour of the facility and noted the main process line had be removed and sold. Mr. Lewis stated in the March 27 phone conversation that he would like to revoke the permit and asked if I could start the process. I did not observe any violations during my inspection.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

I have noted the source status as "Permanently Closed" in ACES and recommend closure in CAATS.

CONCLUSIONS:

No violations were determined during the inspection. The source is permanently closed.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I have prepared an Inspection Summary Letter.
