

Executive Summary
February 2008

Graphs B and E

- The Average Daily Populations for both adult male and female offenders saw large increases in the month of February. The average adult male population reached 24,496 and the average adult female population reached 2,283 for the month.

Graphs C and F

- During February, there were 1,783 male offenders and 125 female offenders being housed in local contracted county jail beds. These offenders are newly sentenced offenders who have completed court documents, who are awaiting transfer to a DOC facility.

Graph G

- The Average Daily Population for juvenile female offenders decreased by 15 offenders from January to February. This marks the largest monthly decrease since December 2005 and the lowest average population since March 2007.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 25,192 adult male offenders (including 1,747 county jail “back-ups” and 100 in contracted beds) on February 29, 2008. This population is 3% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 2,285 adult female offenders (including 125 county jail “back-ups” and 63 in contracted beds) on February 29, 2008. This population is 2% above the operational bed capacity.

- There were 838 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on February 29, 2008. This population is 29% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 161 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on February 29, 2008. This population is 49% below the operational bed capacity.

- There were 9,437 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,672 Indiana parolees and 765 other jurisdiction parolees) on February 29, 2008.

- There were 1,314 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,208 Indiana parolees and 106 other jurisdiction parolees) on February 29, 2008.

- There were 433 juvenile males on parole in Indiana (396 Indiana parolees and 37 other jurisdiction parolees) on February 29, 2008.

- There were 69 juvenile females on parole in Indiana (64 Indiana parolees and 5 other jurisdiction parolees) on February 29, 2008.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

Admission – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

Average Daily Population – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

Beginning Count – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

Class A Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class B Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class C Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Class D Felony – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count) – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

Level 1 Security Classification – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

Level 2 Security Classification – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

Level 3 Security Classification – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

Misdemeanant – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

Murder – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Operational Capacity – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

Pre-Dispositional – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Release – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

Safekeeper – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

Secure Confinement Units – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

Vacancy – The number of beds available for assignment.



Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations Fiscal Year 2008





Average Daily Adult Male Offender Populations Fiscal Year 2008




Adult Males Held in County Jails




