Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments and the asbestos survey have been completed at the site and are currently under review to determine next steps.

Background

The .5-acre former freight depot property still contains the depot building. Plans are for the building to be refurbished and developed into a fire department museum after any environmental contamination issues are addressed. The property will also be used to expand opportunities for the Little Italy Festival. Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) Transportation Enhancement grant funding is being sought to rehabilitate the building.

A trail is planned to connect the freight depot building and the former passenger depot (located 1/2 mile west of the freight depot) with the Wabash River. The passenger depot has already been redeveloped as a museum and the home of the Vermillion County Community Foundation.
