

ORDER 2008-20

AN ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE

The Commission has considered the following factors:

Phillip Green, Robert Harris, Dwayne Henderson, Antonio Ingram, Donald Newton, and James Walton all applied for occupational licenses to work at Indiana riverboats.

None of Phillip Green, Robert Harris, Dwayne Henderson, Donald Newton, or James Walton disclosed felony convictions on their applications for occupational license. They all were issued temporary occupational licenses. After investigating the applications for occupational license, Commission staff determined that these individuals were not suitable for licensure.

After being issued a temporary occupational license, Antonio Ingram was seen at Majestic Star Casino stealing several \$500 chips and running out of the casino. After Commission Agents completed their investigation into this incident, Commission staff determined that Mr. Ingram was not suitable for licensure.


Commission staff revoked each individual's temporary license and notified the individuals that their permanent licenses would be denied at the next Commission meeting if they did not withdraw their applications or proceed with a felony waiver, if applicable. These individuals did not withdraw their applications and have failed to obtain felony waivers where applicable.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby DENIES the Application for Permanent Occupational License of the following individuals:

- Robert Harris
- Dwayne Henderson
- Antonio Ingram
- Donald Newton
- James Walton
